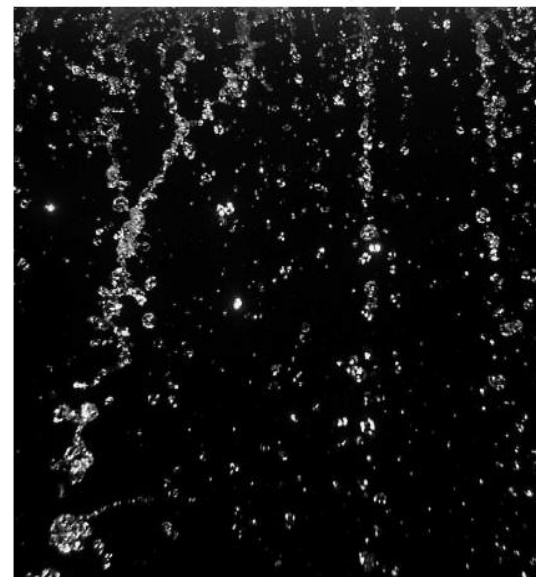

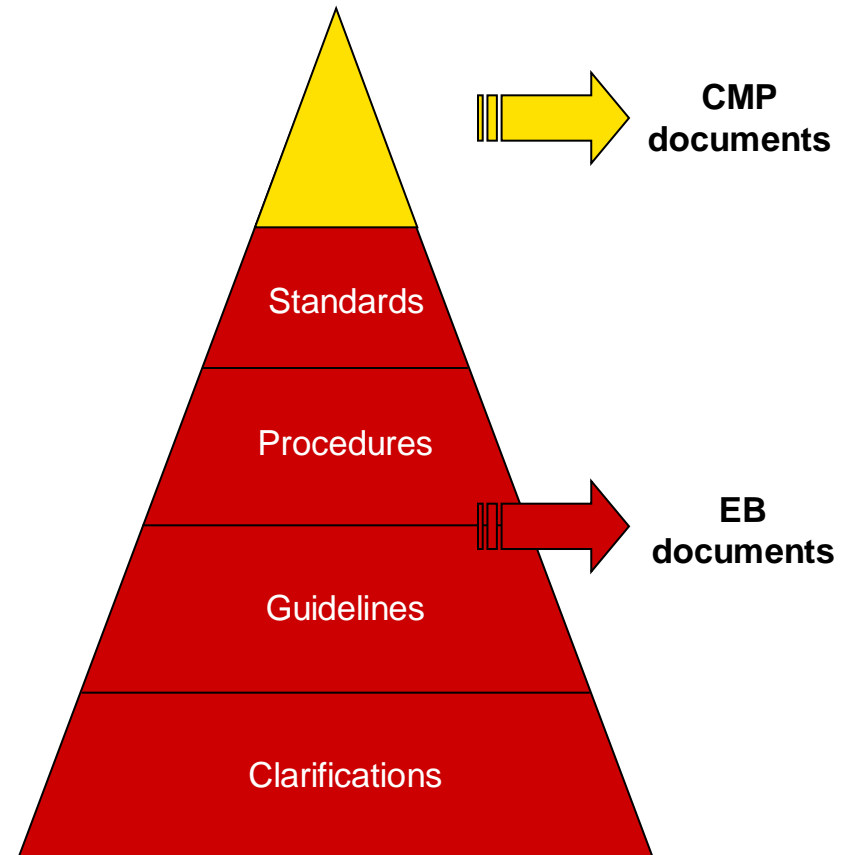

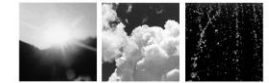

Rapid access to the Board's regulatory decisions is currently provided through these key document types:

Standards

Standards describe mandatory levels or degrees of attainment or performance, designed to achieve a uniform approach to compliance with decisions from the CMP relating to the CDM project activity cycle. *Note: The Validation and Verification manual (VVM) is currently listed under this section. [Approved methodologies](#) can be accessed from the methodologies section of this web site.*

Procedures

Procedures contain mandatory series of actions that must be undertaken to satisfy specific requirements of the CDM modalities and procedures.

Guidelines

Guidelines contain supplemental information such as acceptable methods for satisfying requirements described in procedures or standards.

Clarifications

Clarifications are issued to alleviate confusion that has arisen relating to a standard or procedure and also be located within the main body of the meeting report.

Tools

Tools are used to calculate, determine, demonstrate, estimate, identify and/or test information relating to a CDM project activity and is usually referenced in a standard or a form. When referenced, all or specified components of the tool are required and mandatory.

Forms

Forms facilitate the submission of data or information required in a recurring, standardized business process within the CDM project cycle.

Information Notes

Information notes are messages containing facts relating to a particular subject including the calendar of upcoming meetings, budget information, work programmes, policy frameworks and other information of an operational or administrative nature. Additionally, information notes are used to supply information regarding rulings of the Board relating to registration and issuance.

32. The Board revised the following approved methodologies:

- AM0028:** The revision broadens the applicability of the methodology to cover project activities in [annex 4](#) of this report;
- AM0034:** The revision provides more precise guidance as to how the monitored data for project activities should be collected, both baseline and project campaigns. Furthermore, the revision removes the provision defining the normal campaign length and identifying the range of operating parameters that exists among the five campaigns immediately previous to the baseline campaign;
- AM0048:** The revision: (i) incorporates the "Tool to calculate project or host country CO₂e emissions from fossil fuel combustion" which addresses inconsistencies in the units for some parameters in equations (22) and (23). The approved revised methodology is contained in [annex 6](#) of this report;
- ACM0002:** The revision waives the projects of capacity addition in wind, solar, wave or tidal power plants from the applicability condition that requires the availability of 5 year historical data for capacity addition, retrofit and rehabilitation projects. The electricity generated by the added capacities is directly measured under these projects. The approved revised methodology is contained in [annex 7](#) of this report;
