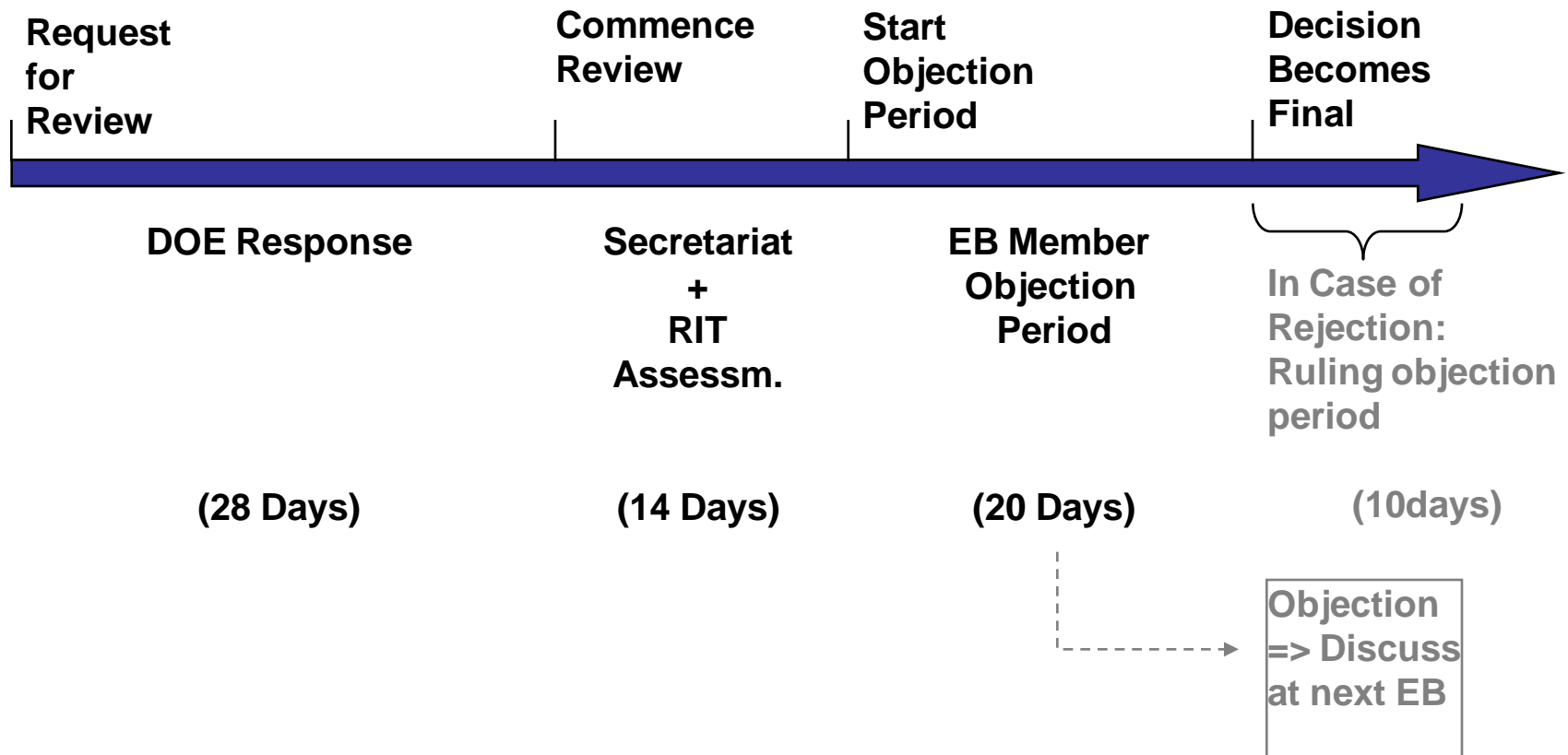

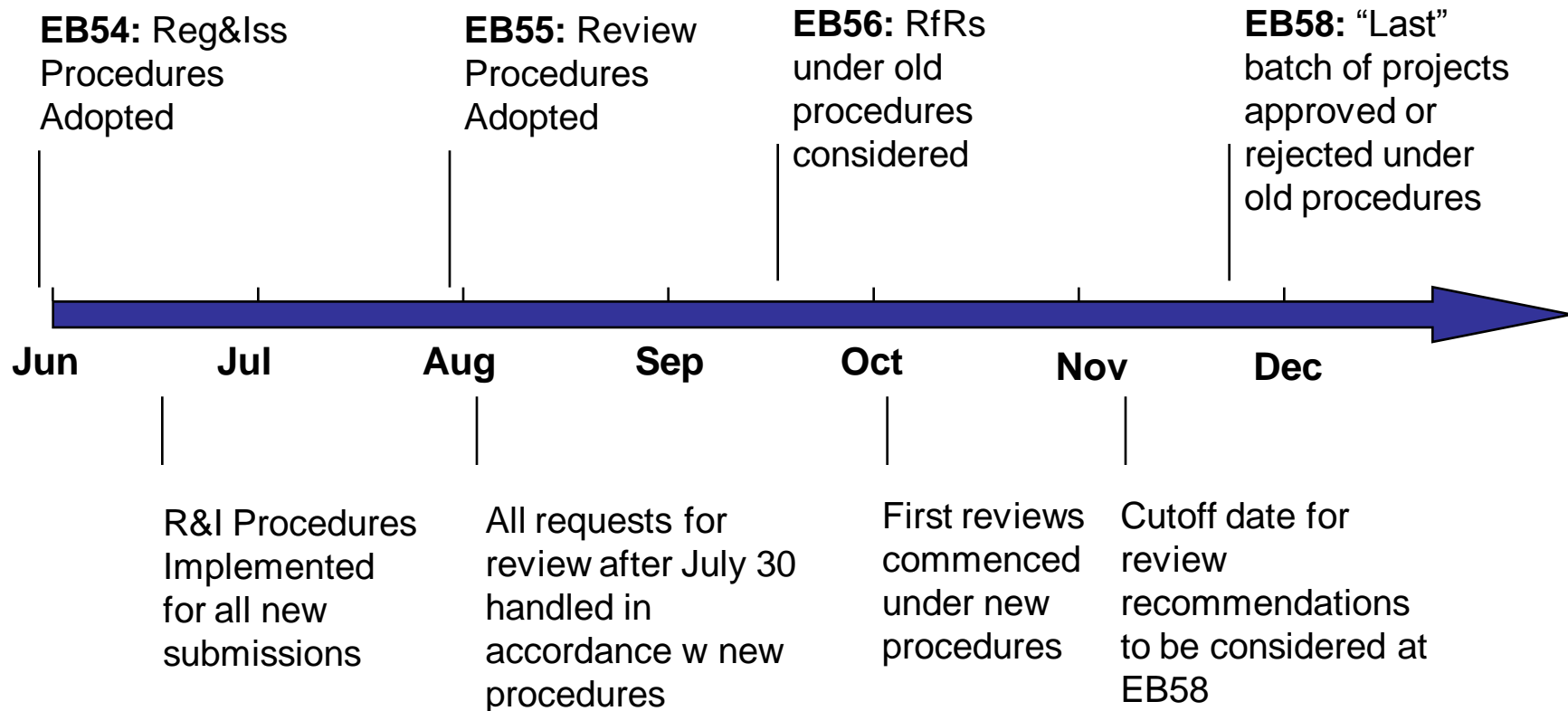

# Current Status of Review Cases, as of Oct 11

---

## Registration:

- **Old Procedure:** 26 cases under review. Final decision at EB58
- **New Procedure:** Review requested for 55 cases, of which 19 cases have been commenced

## Issuance:

- **Old Procedure:** 9 cases under review. Final decision at EB58
- **New Procedure:** Review requested for 33 cases, of which 15 cases have been commenced

# Efforts Underway

---

- **New staff under recruitment in accordance with MAP**
- **Working with external experts (including RIT) to support secretariat case administration. Additional experts under recruitment**
- **Adjusting and improving electronic workflows to handle cases faster and more consistently**
- **Reducing the backlog depends also on the level and quality of submissions.**
  - a) **Issuance requests exceeding MAP expectations**
  - b) **Resubmissions constitute more than 40 percent of current registration requests and 11 percent of issuance requests awaiting processing. Secretariat expects resubmissions to decline**
