MANDATE

Decision 3/CMP.6 paragraph 37

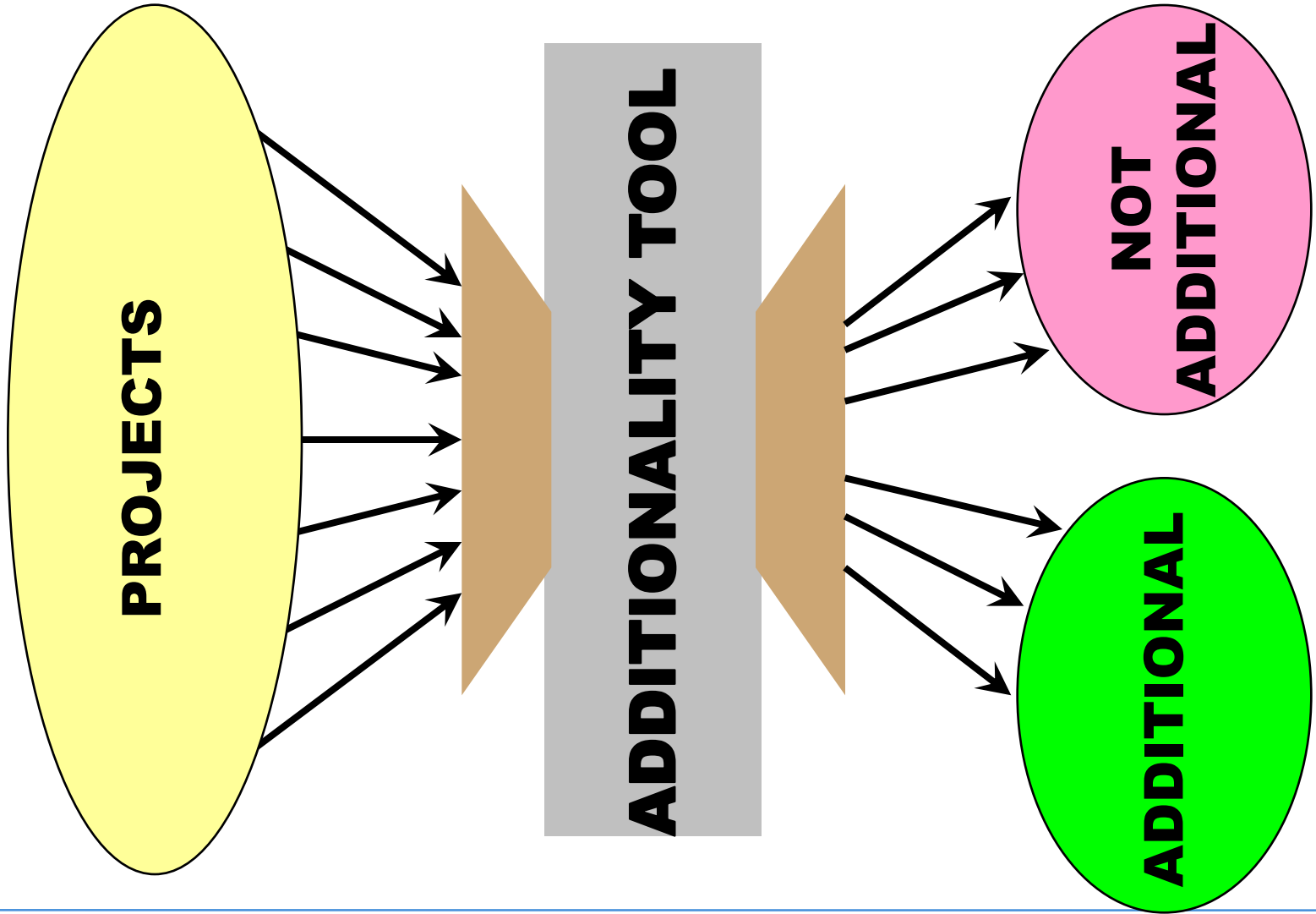
The Board, as highest priority, to finalize guidance on the use of:

- **First-of-its-kind barrier (FoiK); and**
- **Assessment of common practice (CP)**

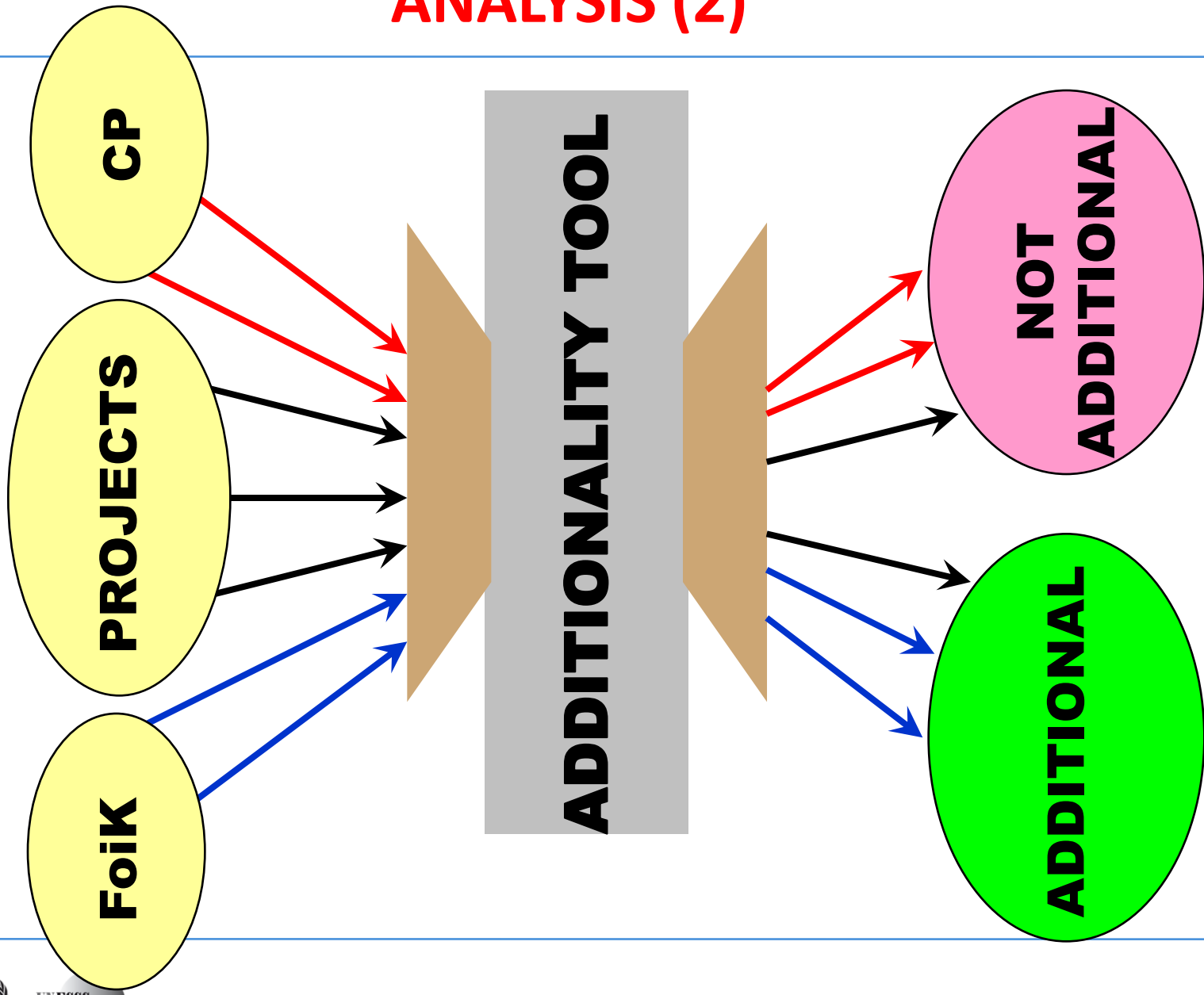
Currently both are applied in:

- **Tool for the demonstration and assessment of additionality; and**
- **Combined tool to identify the baseline scenario and demonstrate additionality**

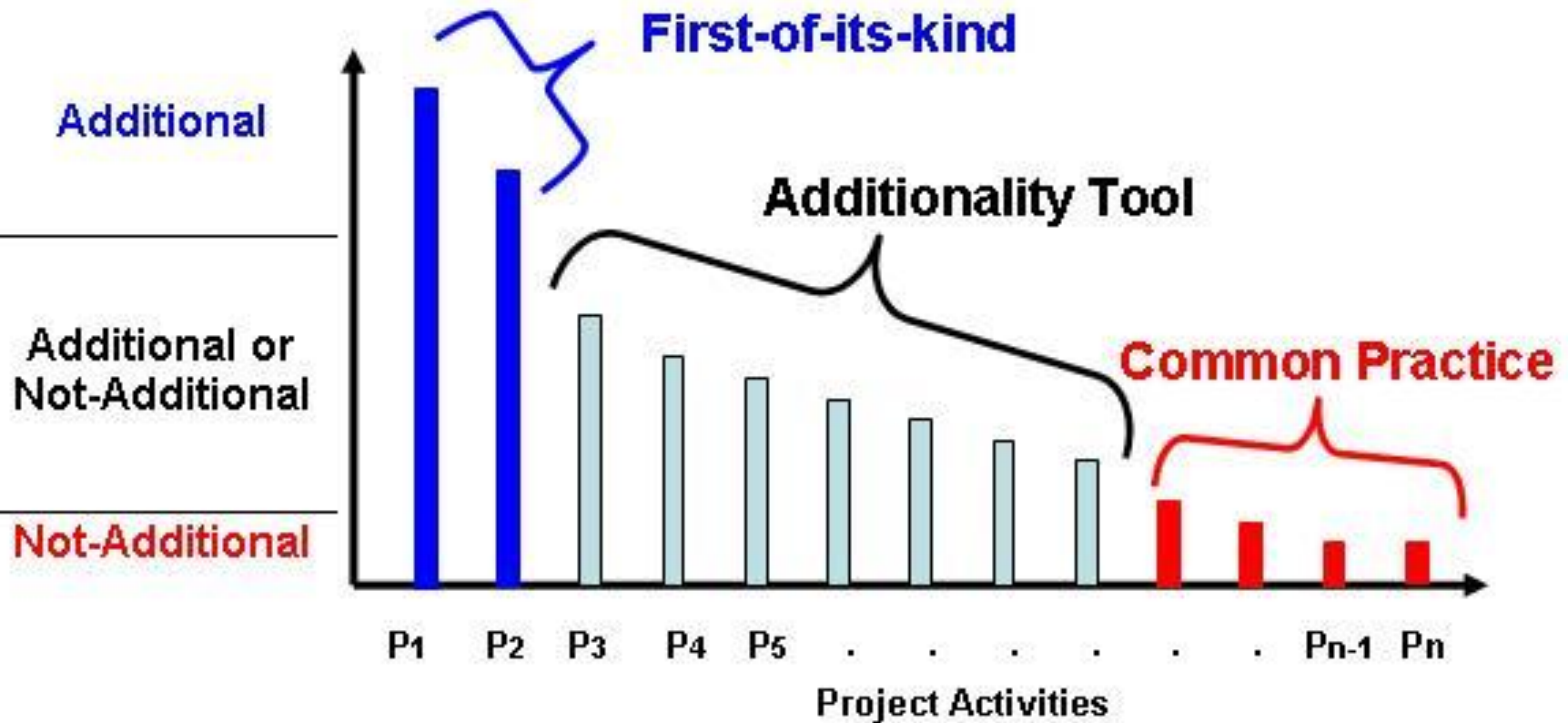

OUTCOME OF THE ANALYSIS



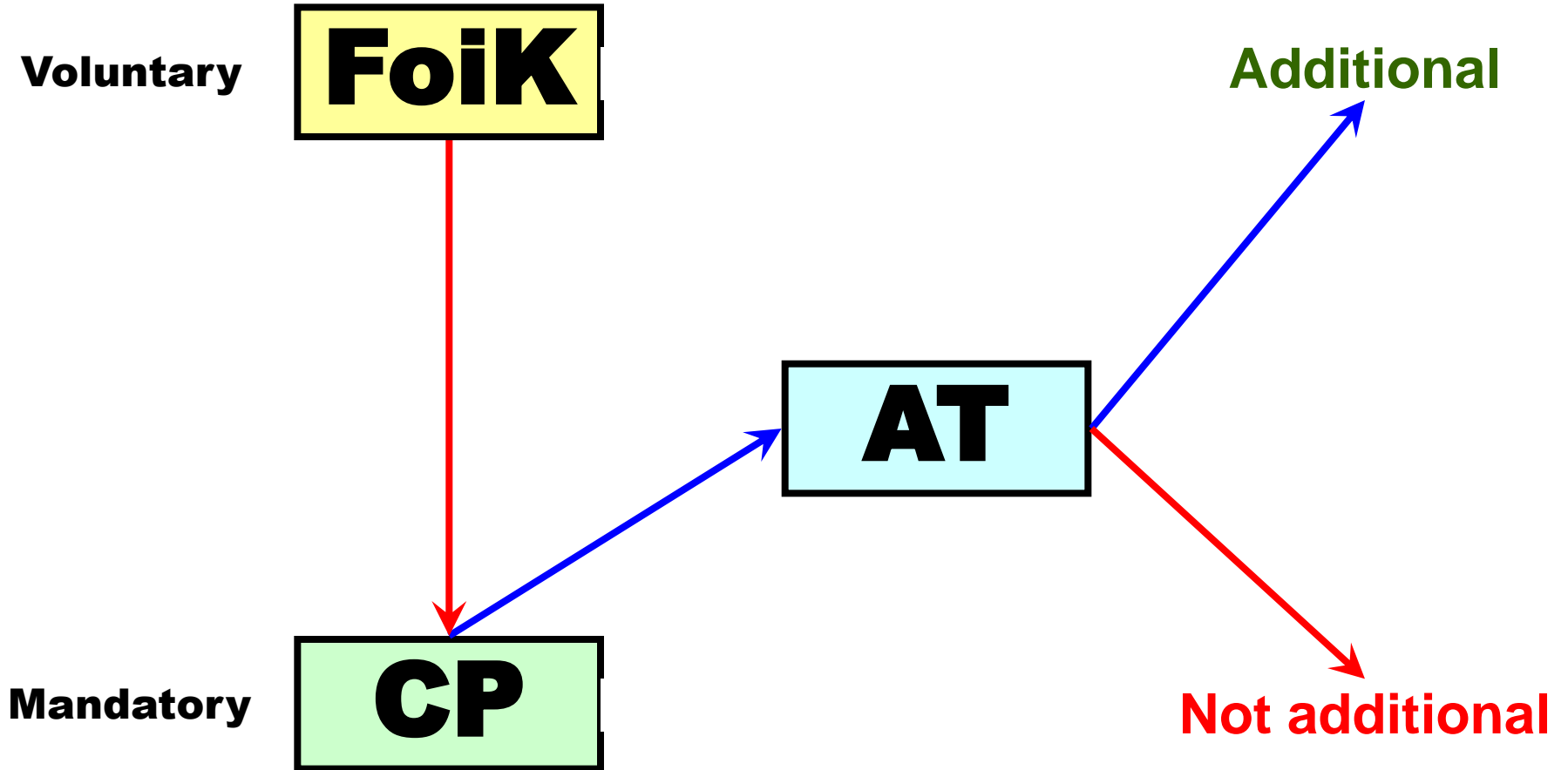
GOAL

To develop screening instruments to streamline additionality demonstration:

- First-of-its-kind: to identify projects that are obviously additional based on their performance against other activities providing the same output**
- Common practice: to identify projects that are obviously not additional based on their performance against other activities providing the same output**



APPROACH



APPROACH (cntd.)

- 1. Performance is a basis for identification of Foik and CP projects**
- 2. The details of approaches for assessment of the performance may differ between categories of projects (e.g. “renewables” and “non-renewables”)**
- 3. A project that has not passed the test for Foik may be additional by means of additionality demonstration using the AT**



APPROACH (cntd.)

- 1. A project that has passed the test for CP (i.e. the project is not a CP) may be additional or not additional by means of additionality demonstration using the AT**
- 2. A project that has not passed the test for CP (i.e. the project is a CP) is not additional**



PROPOSED ACTION (“First-of-its kind”)

Take a step-wise approach:

- **“First-of-its kind” guidance on renewable energy projects**
- **“First-of-its kind” guidance on fuel switch in projects**
- **Continue with other sectors / project types**



PROPOSED ACTION (“Common practice”)

Take a step-wise approach:

- “Common practice” guidance for energy generation for a grid
- Continue with other sectors / project types
