Scope of the report

- Progress of EB activities during the reporting period
- Assist Parties and the CMP president to focus discussions at the CMP by making recommendations on required actions
- Request guidance, as appropriate
- Reporting period
→ 15 October 2010 (after EB 57) – 26 October 2011 (until EB 64)
- Due to UN rules, report is to be short (about 20 pages)



Structure of the report

- Introduction
 - Mandate, scope, action to be taken by the CMP
- Achievements and challenges
 - Key messages
- Work undertaken
 - Factual information on deliverables during the reporting period
- Governance matters
 - Factual information on outreach activities, interaction with bodies and stakeholders, membership issues, meetings
- Management plan and resources



Key messages agreed at EB 62

- Fulfill CMP mandates and ensure effective operation of the CDM
- Highlight work until now - CDM is "fit for the future" and getting fitter; ready for future use by Parties whichever way they wish
- CDM contribution to mitigation and sustainable development
- Increased consultation with stakeholders and DNAs
- Need for technical and management preparations for 2012
- Strong interest on the future of the CDM, especially private sector
- Lack of complete clarity on future of CDM creates difficulties for the Board – need clear guidance to do proper planning
- Do not reinvent the wheel – CDM can be adapted to new needs
- Revision of the modalities and procedures should start next year
