Activities in 2011

- DNAs:
 - Project cycle training for Asia Pacific (Energy/Wastewater) and African (Energy/ Waste) DNAs
 - Standardized baselines workshop for all DNAs (Kathmandu, Nepal)
- DOEs:
 - Regional calibration workshops (India and China).
- Other:
 - Investment analysis training for DOEs/PPs organized with Project Developers Forum

Proposed focus areas in 2012

- DNAs:
 - 1 basic project cycle training for new DNAs/ new staff at DNAs to be held in Bonn
 - Training on standardized baselines and PoA to be run in LAC, ASP and AFR – longer sessions possibly in conjunction with Nairobi Framework and other partners
- DOEs:
 - Regional calibration workshops focused on new project cycle documentation
- Other stakeholders:
 - Continue to contribute where possible to events planned by others and provide additional online content



Proposed means of delivery

- Learning management system: Initially piloted for internal secretariat use and rolled out to external users in mid-year
- e-Learning: Providing portal for content of partner organizations followed by UNFCCC prepared content
- On-site training to be complemented with off-site support and preparation



Next steps

- Executive Board discussion on priority areas/focus
- Further analysis of DOE preferences and requirements
- Proposals contained in CDM-MAP 2012



- Propose that the Board, reflecting the approach taken in some ISO standards, offer accredited training courses for practitioners – which would include Secretariat staff, consultants, DOEs and PPs.
- Rather than placing all of the burden on the Secretariat, an accredited training program would accredit third parties to run courses on the CDM. This would be a revenue generating mechanism, whereby the accredited entities pay a fee to the Secretariat to receive the regular updates.
- Development of an accredited training program is one of the PD-Forum's topics for CMP7.
