- continued uncertainty under which working
- inadequacy of financial resources
- status of accruing of fees to cover costs from 2010
- interaction with stakeholders/actors
- concerns raised by stakeholders/actors (incl. uncertainty of future of JI)
- status of accreditation process
- experience to date with procedures, guidelines, etc. of the JISC
