- JISC continued operation of verification procedure and accreditation process
- JISC adopted/revised various procedures, clarifications and guidelines to further improve the JI operation
- JISC is developing DVM and PoA
- JISC will further revise or clarify existing documents based on inputs from stakeholders
- JISC made efforts for hearing inputs from stakeholders through workshop, roundtable and public calls and regular invitation of DOE/AIE coordination forum to JISC meetings
- JISC is considering establishing communication channel with project participants

Key messages (cont.)

- Financial resources continued inadequate
- Revenues from fees are far from adequate to start self-financing from 2010
- Encourage Parties to continue voluntary contribution
