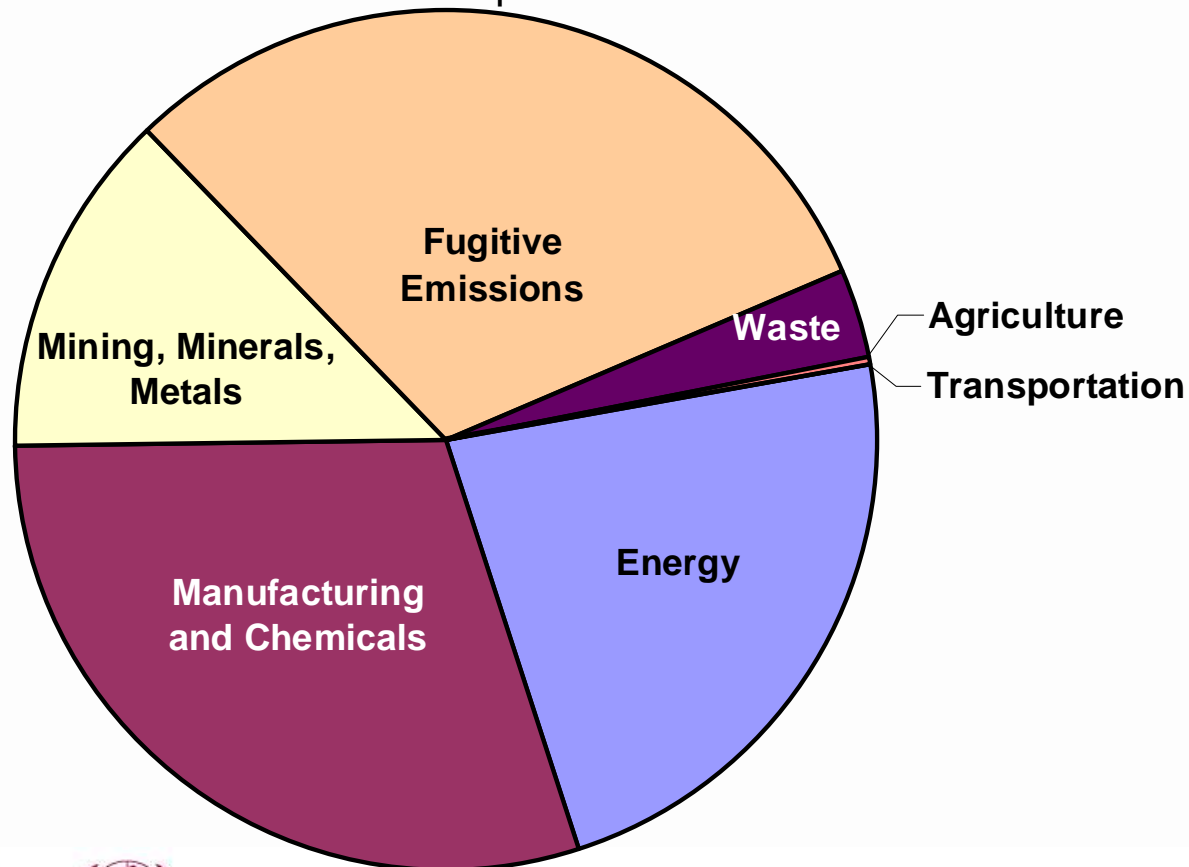

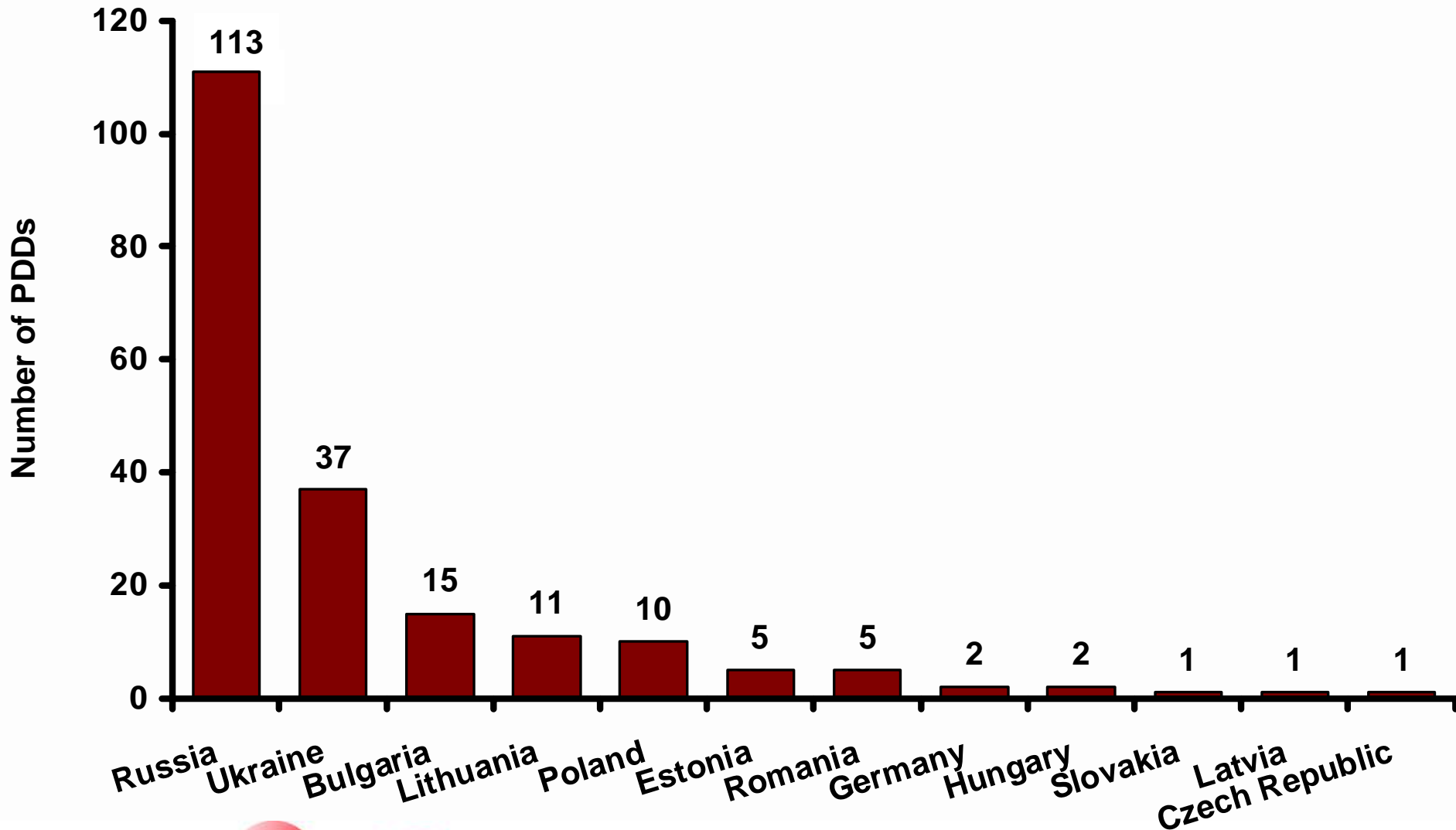
Project design documents (PDDs)

203 PDDs have been published for comments:

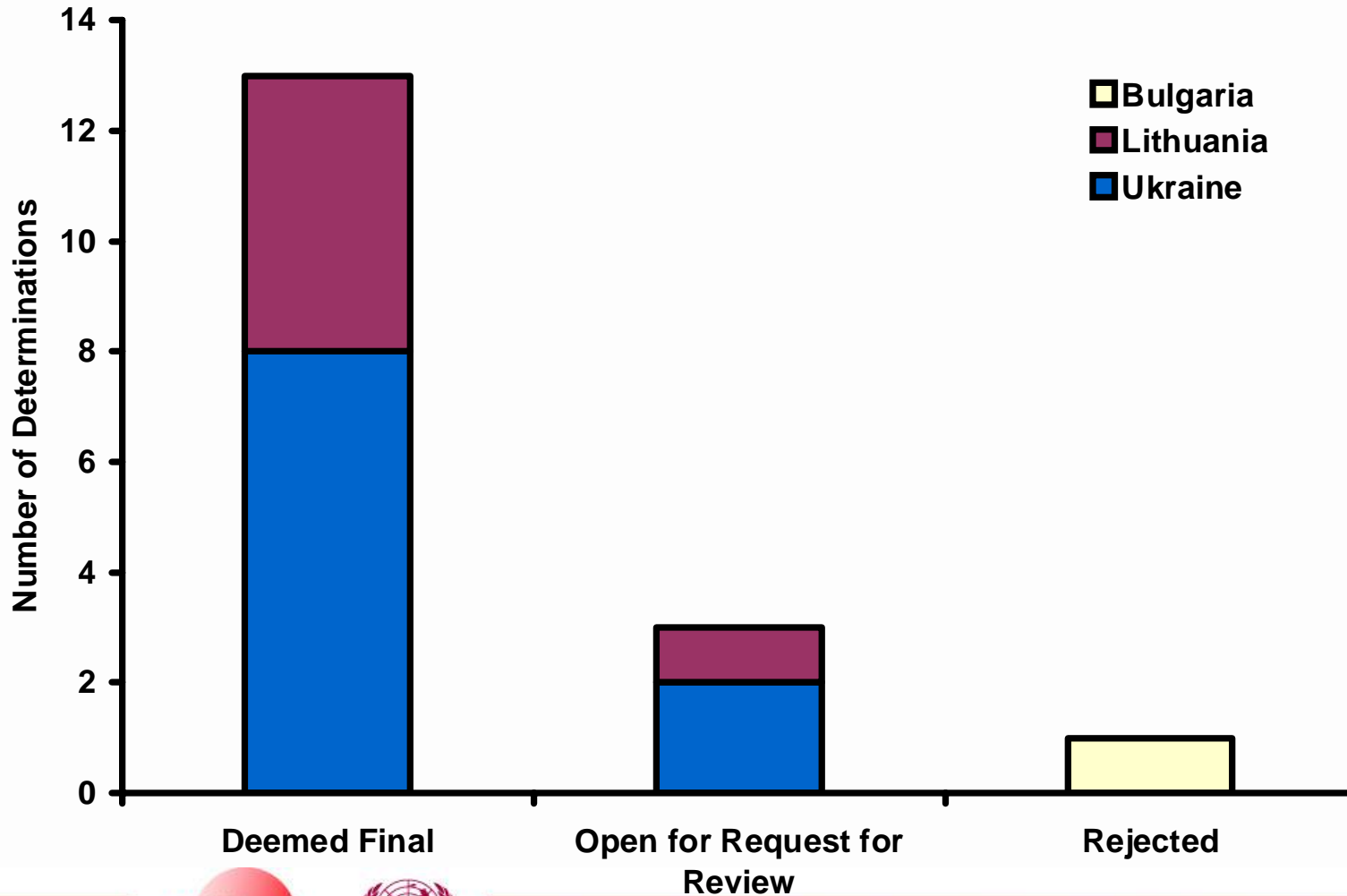
- Emission reductions 2008 - 2012: ~ 320 million tonnes CO₂ equivalent, across a multitude of sectoral scopes
