General issues

CMP 5 considered the JISC's annual report and JISC Chair's oral report and adopted **Decision 3/CMP.5** "Guidance on the implementation of Art. 6 of the Kyoto Protocol" – positive outcome (appreciation of the JISC excellent work)

Recognized - the work done on JI (esp. under the verification procedure)

- the necessity of sufficient financial and human resources
- the potential increase in the number of JI projects

Expressed appreciation to Parties that contributed to funding the work on JI

JISC encouraged to continue:

- working in facilitating the process of accrediting IEs
- enhancing the implementation of verification procedure considering the distinct characteristics of JI
- promoting transparency and enhancing interaction with DFPs, IEs, PPs, etc

General issues (2)

JISC requested to:

- conduct an assessment of the implications of possible inclusion of the concepts of materiality and level of assurance in JI determination/verification
- report to CMP 6 on its experiences with the JI verification procedure, with a view to making improvements for the future operation of JI
- keep its guidance under review regarding Appendix B of the JI guidelines and revise it in order to improve the clarity of the provisions

Parties encouraged to:

- ensure that information provided on JI Track 1 projects is sufficiently detailed to provide an overview of these projects in a transparent way

Secretariat, in consultation with DFPs, requested to:

- improve the web-based interface by standardizing the information to be provided on JI Track 1 and agreeing on minimum amount of info required



Governance

Commended JISC for maintaining a JI management plan (MAP) and for its responsiveness to the needs of Parties, IEs, PPs, stakeholders and public

JISC encouraged to:

- continue to keep the JI MAP under review and make adjustments
- enhance its interaction with DFPs, PPs and IEs
- make every effort towards a more transparent, consistent, predictable and efficient verification procedure (in cooperation with DFPs, IEs, and PPs)

JISC and the secretariat requested to:

- enhance their outreach activities to improve overall understanding of JI

IEs encouraged to:

- continue to build and improve their capacity to appropriately perform their functions under the verification procedure



Resources

Endorsed the revision of the fee structure as recommended by the JISC

Noted with concern that the income from charging of fees that has accrued to date is significantly lower than the level required to cover the administrative costs of JI activities and this may be possible only as of 2012

JISC requested to report to CMP 6 on a financial and budget projection up to 2012, including an analysis of time and conditions for the JISC to become self financing

Annex I Parties urged to make contributions to the Trust Fund for funding JI work in the biennium 2010-2011 (to ensure implementation of JI MAP)

Elements of the CMP decision need to be addressed by the JISC both substantially and in terms of JISC work programme planning
