- JI-AT established for 15 applications
- Indicative letter issued to 14 applications
- Witnessing opportunities: 22 accepted (1 more than last period)
 - 6 witnessing opportunities withdrawn (same)
 - 5 witnessing activities completed (same)
 - 11 waiting in the pipeline (1 more)

Accreditation

- 4 accredited independent entities (AIEs) (1 more than last period)

JI accreditation standard

- Submission of a second draft “JI accreditation standard (version 01)” to the JISC for its consideration and adoption

JI accreditation procedure

- Submission of a draft “Procedure for accrediting independent entities by the Joint Implementation Supervisory Committee (version 06)” to the JISC for its consideration and adoption

Witnessing activity stage

- Submission of an information note “Analysis and options for changes of the procedures on witnessing activities in the joint implementation accreditation process” to the JISC for its consideration

Suspension of DOEs' accreditation

- Submission of an information note “Analysis on implications of suspension of designated operational entities under the clean development mechanism on the status of accreditation of the same entities under Joint Implementation” to the JISC for its consideration

Roster of experts

- 39 experts on the roster (1 less than the previous period)

Issues under consideration

- Management of JI-AT experts, including the implementation of an on-line training course and the organization of a workshop for experts on the roster
- Revision of forms to be used in the JI accreditation process
