# Sample of Previous JISC Outreach Activities

---

- **First UNFCCC Workshop** on the implementation of Article 6 projects under the Kyoto Protocol - May 2004 (**before JISC establishment**)
- **5 UNFCCC JI Technical Workshops organized by JISC** - Mar. 2006, Feb. and Oct. 2007, Sep. 2008, Sep. 2009
- **2 Roundtable consultations** in 2008 & 2009 (e.g. discussion on DVM and PoA)
- **8 Q&A sessions** (during all SBs and CMPs)
- **3 side events** (during CMP.1, CMP.2 and CMP.4)



# Other JI-related Outreach Activities

---

- **Participation of JISC members/alternates** in annual carbon market events (CarbonExpo, Carbon Market Insights, etc.)
- **Participation of JI team** in different events and meetings: Austrian JI/CDM workshop, Russian Carbon Market Forum, Carbon Forum America, Climate Change and Business Kiev, etc.
- **Participation of the UNFCCC secretariat as exhibitor** at relevant carbon market events
- **Folders with JI-related information** prepared by the secretariat, updated periodically and distributed in all workshops, meetings and other events



# JI UNFCCC Website

---

**JI interface on UNFCCC webpage** (operational since mid-2007) contains:

- DFPs and procedures of Parties involved in JI
- JISC composition and meetings
- Criteria for baseline setting and monitoring + PoA
- Status of JI Projects (both Track 2 and Track 1)
- References (decisions, procedures, forms, guidance)
- Other issues (news, side-events, workshops, extranets)

**JI webpage visitors** – 9,762 users (monthly average)

- Registered users – 1,868
- News facility users (JI newsletter) – 1,752 (public, stakeholders)



# Possible activities in 2010-2011 biennium

---

- **Increase participation** of JISC (through presentations) in external events
- **Request the secretariat** to organize JI workshops & roundtables
  - Decide on location (Bonn, JI host countries); structure/participation; agenda (e.g. materiality; JI in post 2012 regime; DFPs work on JI)
  - Establish a DFP forum
- **Request the secretariat** to continue outreach activities such as:
  - Improving structure, format and information on the JI website
  - Publishing JI-related articles on relevant web-portals and organizing interviews with JISC members/alternates
  - Preparing “FAQ” for JI and a leaflet with “success stories” in JI projects
  - Organizing JI-related events during important carbon market events
  - Develop a communication strategy
