### Scope of the report

  - To recommend that the secretariat accepts PDDs for publication and that the JISC considers them, in accordance with the JI guidelines, before an amendment to include host Parties in Annex B to the Kyoto Protocol enters into force;
  - Any recommendation coming from the report on experience with the verification procedure under the JISC;
  - To take note critical financial situation for the work of the JISC;
  - To request for further guidance, as appropriate.
- Reporting period: 24 October 2009 (after JISC 18) – 23 October 2010 (JISC 23)
- The draft (annex to the annotations) included placeholders for the issues that were to be considered by the JISC at this meeting. Data and figures will be updated after the meeting.
- The document is currently unedited and will go through the UN editorial process
