SUMMARY OF PROJECT STATUS AS OF 20 OCT. 2010

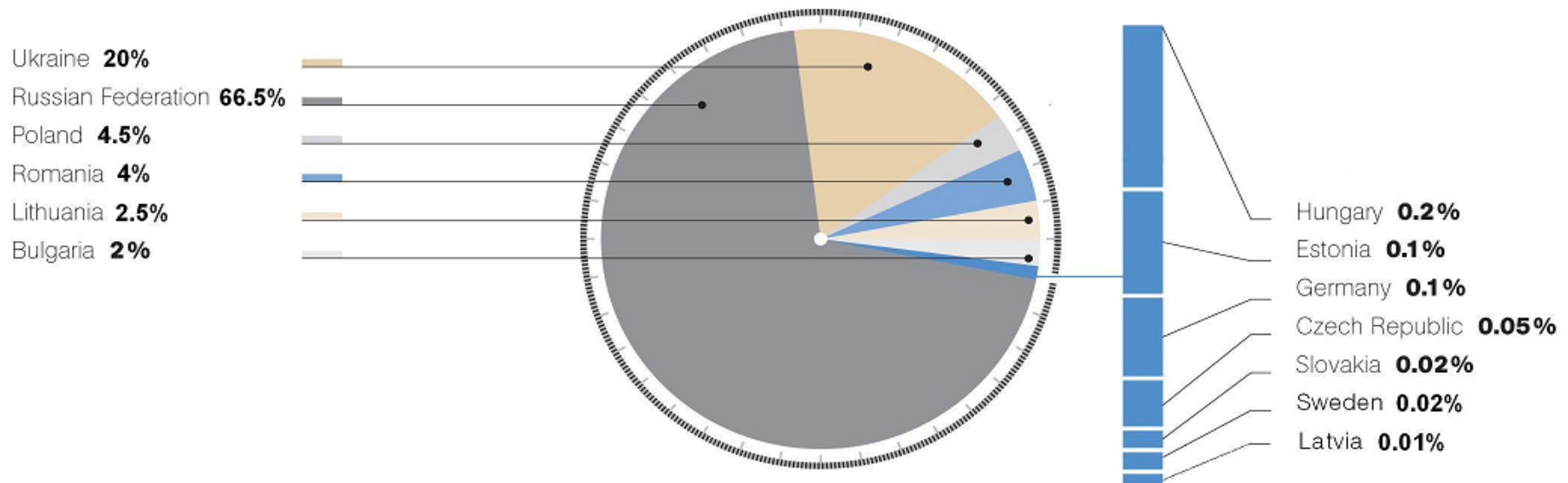
- **236 PDDs** in 12 sectoral scopes published under Track 2 ~ 335 Mt CO₂ eq.
- **39 PDDs** withdrawn from Track 2 ~ 35 Mt CO₂ eq.
- **27 determinations** regarding Track 2 PDDs (in 5 Parties) published, from which:
 - 22 positive determinations deemed final (35 Mt CO₂e in 2008-2012)
 - 1 determination rejected by the JISC
 - 1 determination under review
 - 3 determinations opened for requests for review
- **22 verifications** of emission reductions (generated by determined Track 2 projects) published, from which:
 - 22 positive verifications deemed final (4.2 Mt CO₂e as ERUs possible to issue)
- **190 Track 1 projects** (in 12 Parties) published on the JI UNFCCC website



JI TRACK 2 PDDs PUBLISHED

- **236 JI Track 2** project design documents (PDDs) published on UNFCCC JI website with emission reductions from active projects of approximately **300 Mt CO₂** equivalent during the first commitment period (**2008-2012**)

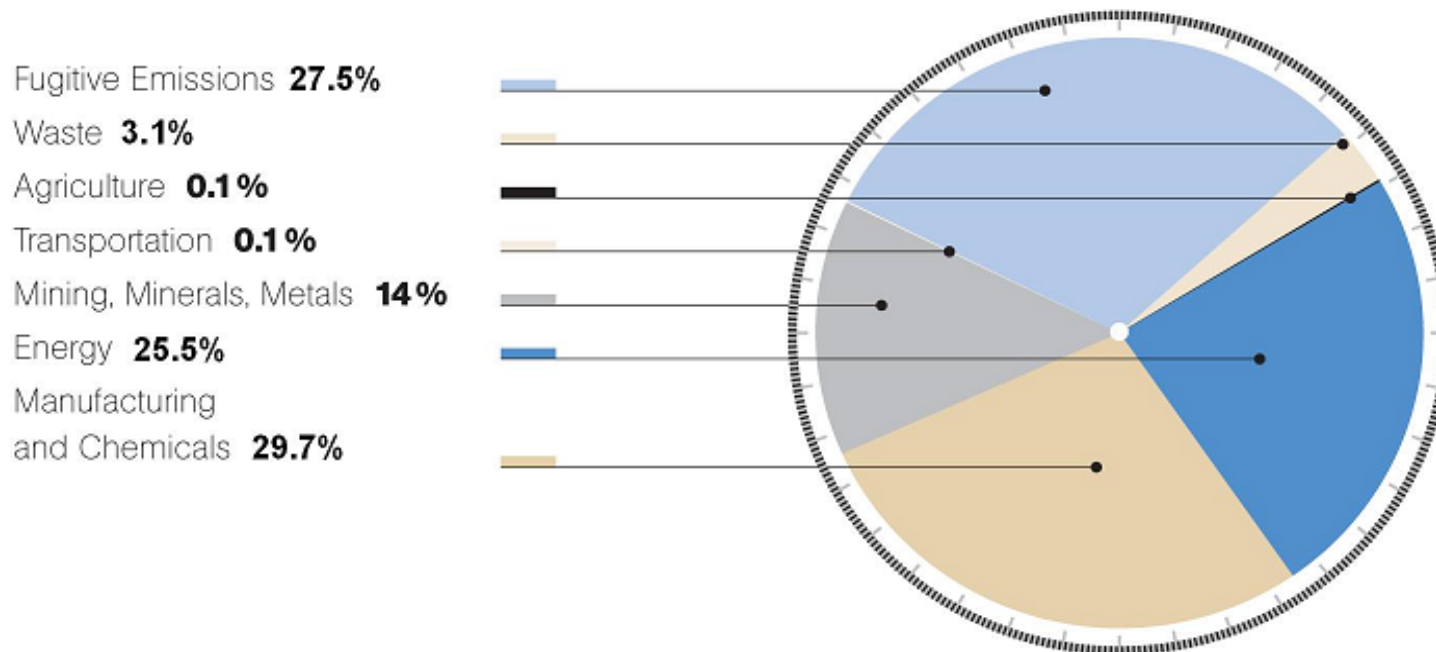
JI Track 2 total emission reductions (proposals), 2008–12, by country



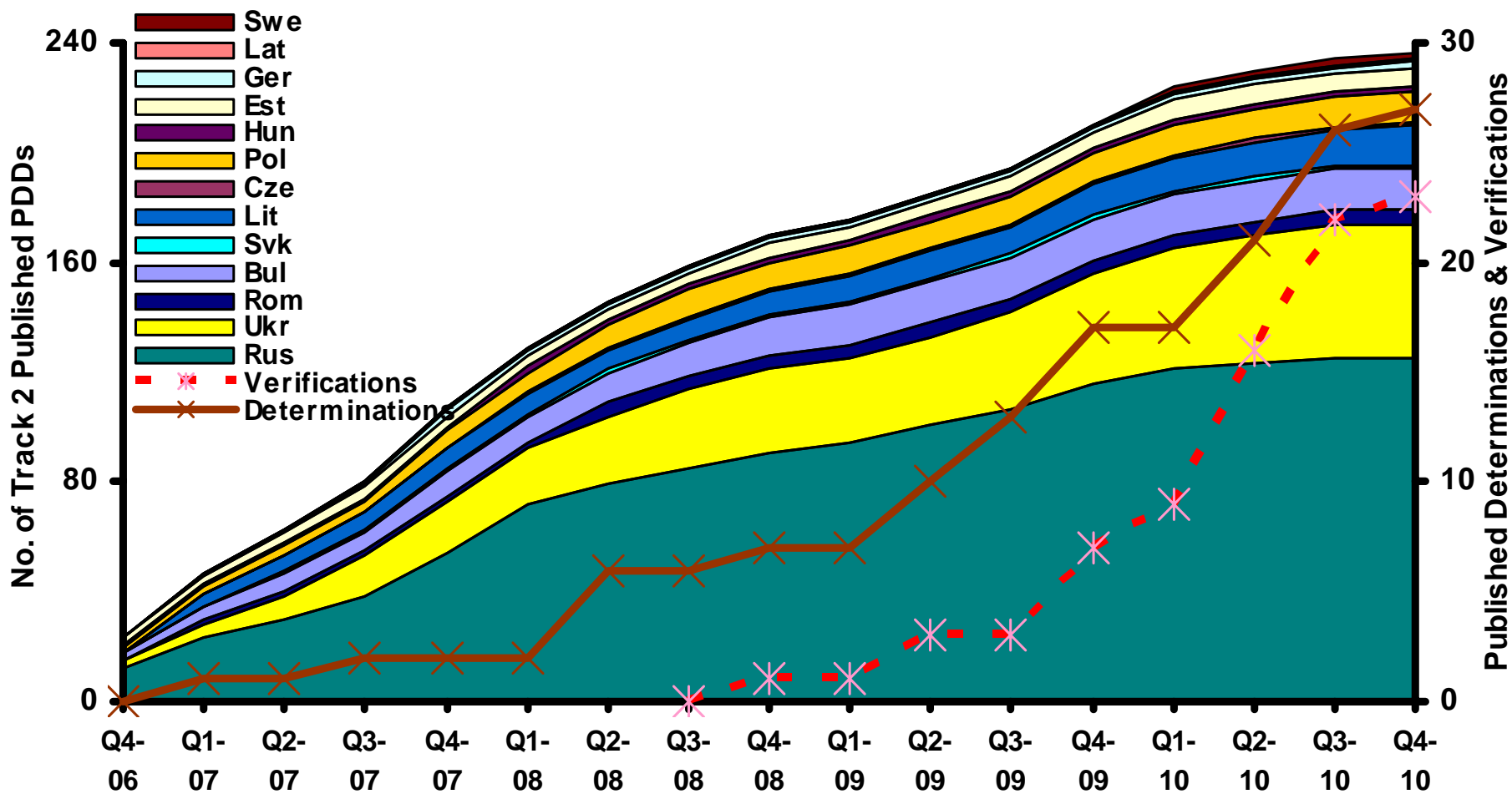

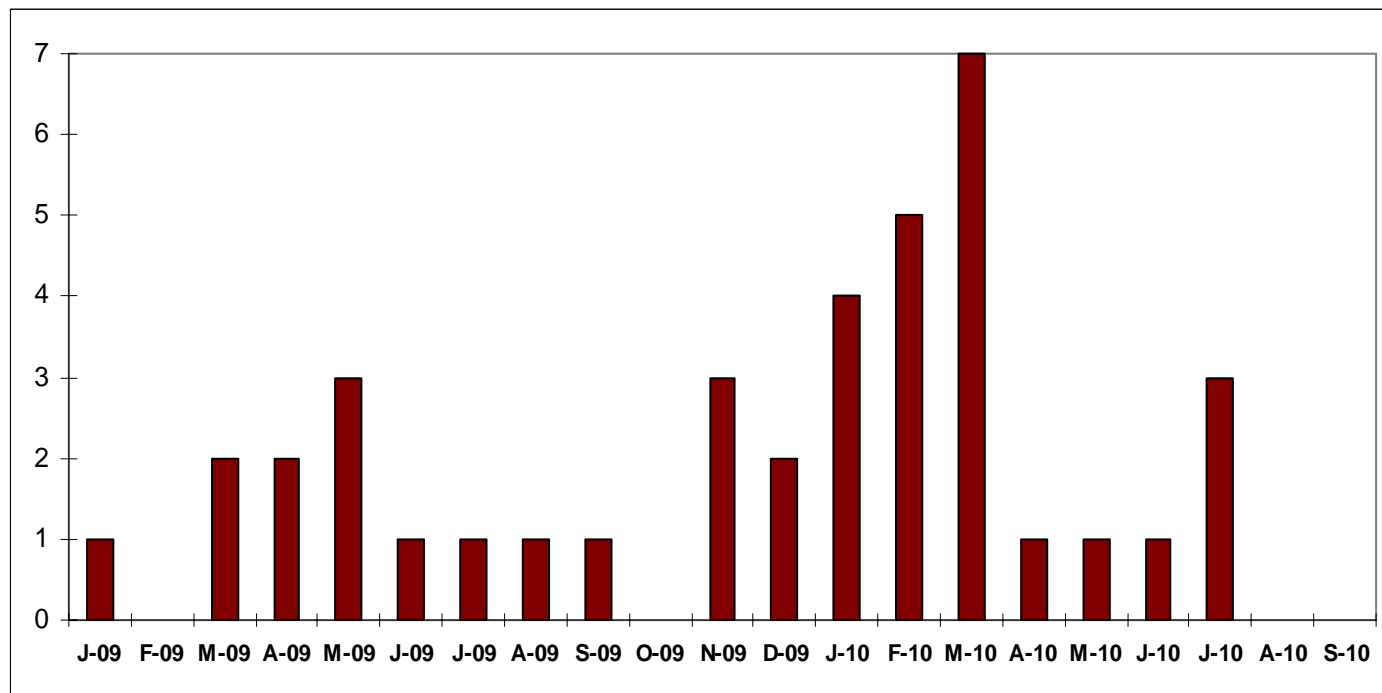

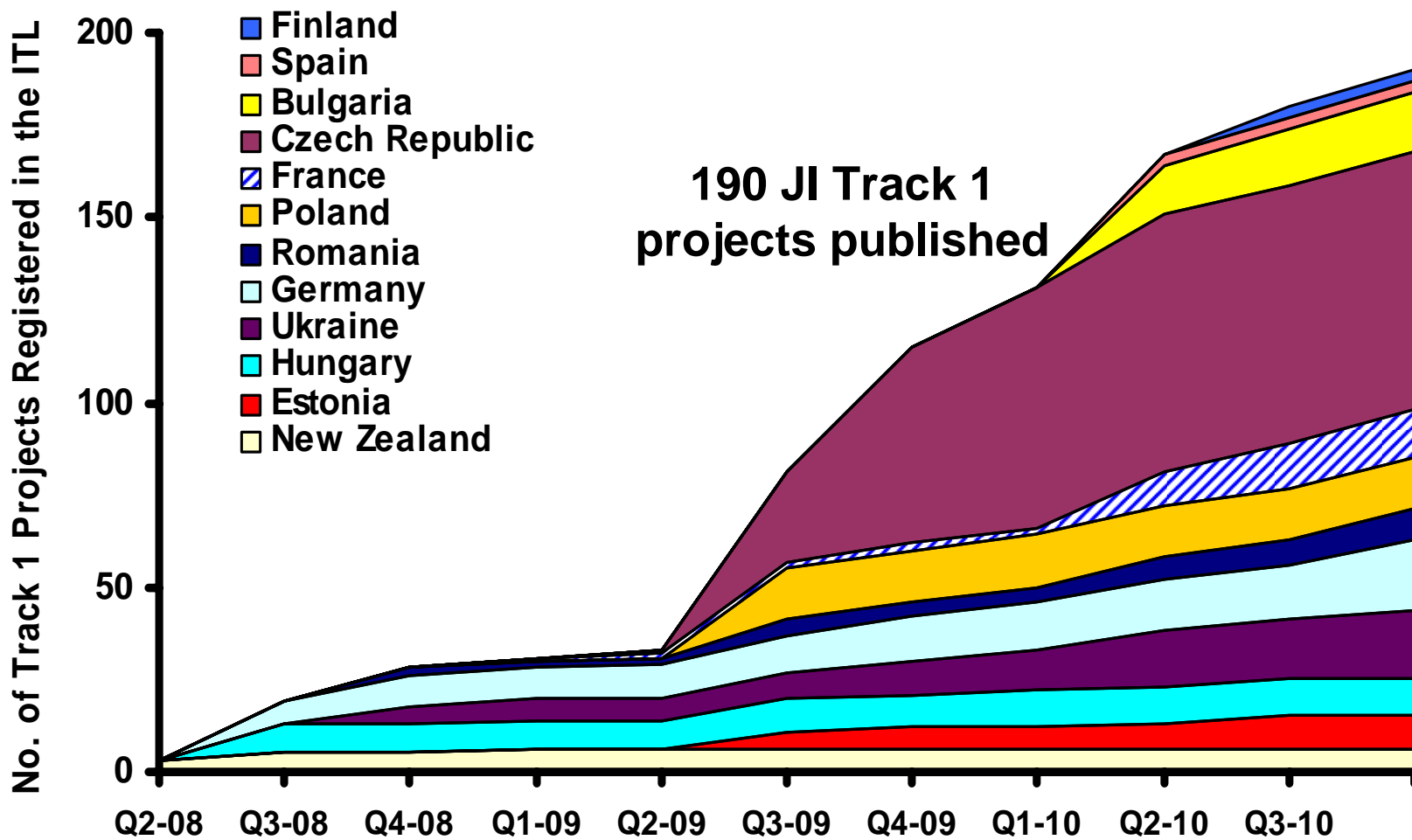

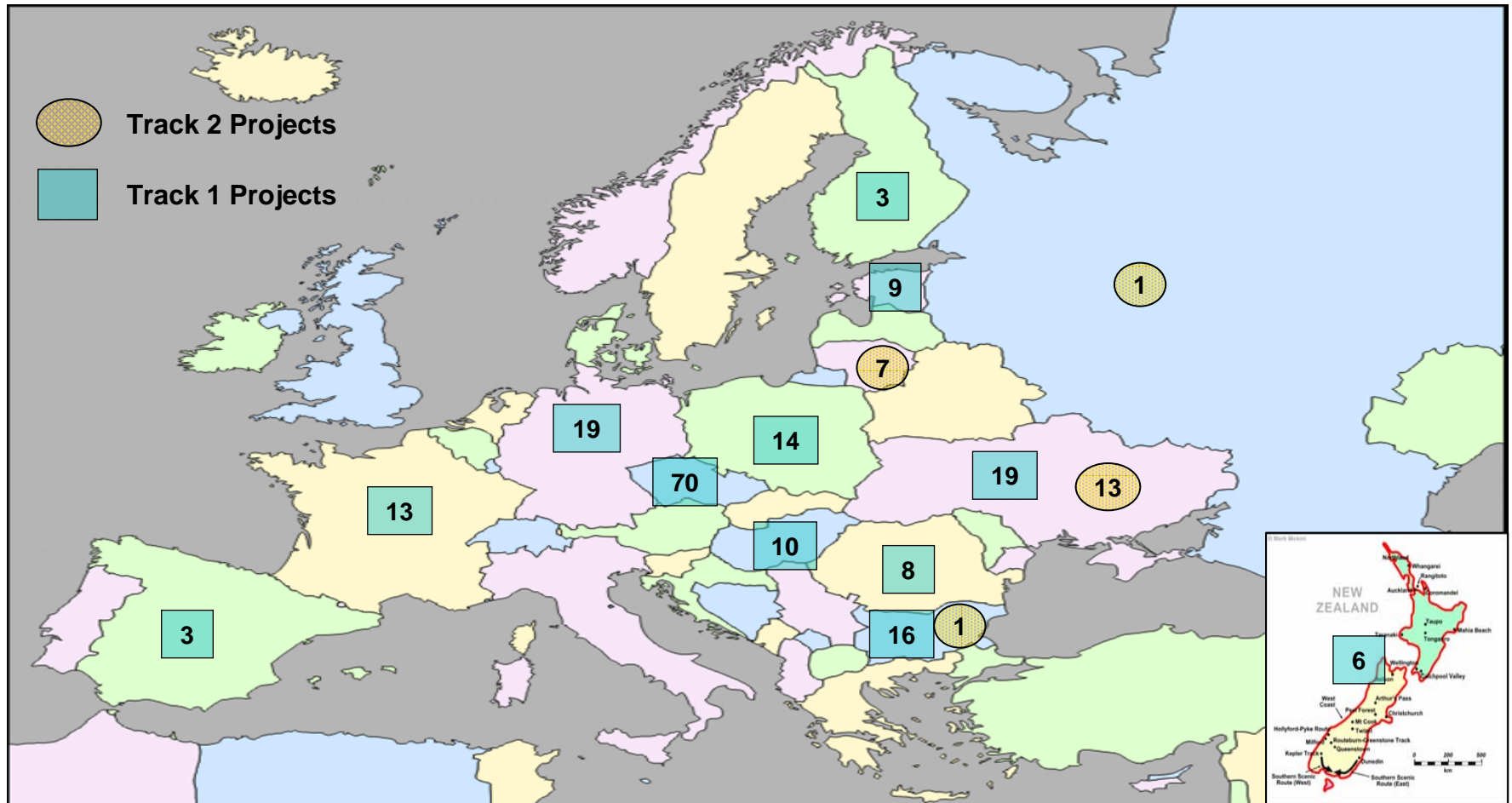

 - b) 29 Annex I Parties have submitted their procedures for approving JI projects


