Request from JISC22

- The JISC at its 22nd meeting agreed to request the DOE/AIE coordination forum to provide inputs on the functions listed in paragraph 39 of the JI accreditation standard (version 01) whether the forum wishes AIEs be allowed to delegate some of these functions to entities/individuals outside AIEs.

Request from JISC22

- Forum members in principle agree with the paragraph the way it was proposed
- However, IEs should be able to delegate to their Related Bodies the duties specified in item (h) – “Implementing the proposal and contract review procedure”

Request from JISC22

- ❑ Most important functions remain in the AIE central office
- ❑ Prevent PPs from the need of entering in international contracts (tax implications)
- ❑ Stop unnecessary money flow back and forth across borders
