## APPLICATIONS FOR ACCREDITATION

- JI-ATs established for all 14 applicants (no new JI-ATs)
- Indicative letters issued to 13 applicants (no new indicative letters)
- Witnessing opportunities: 22 accepted (same)
  - a) 6 witnessing opportunities withdrawn (same)
  - b) 5 witnessing activities completed (same)
  - c) 3 witnessing activities underway (3 new)
