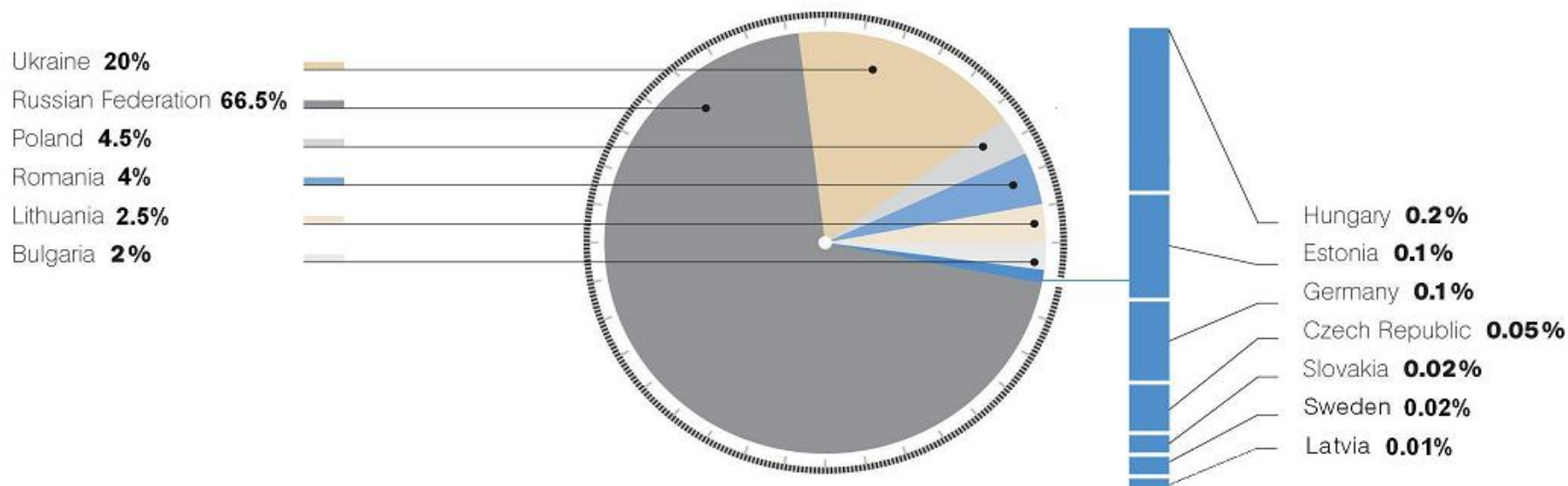

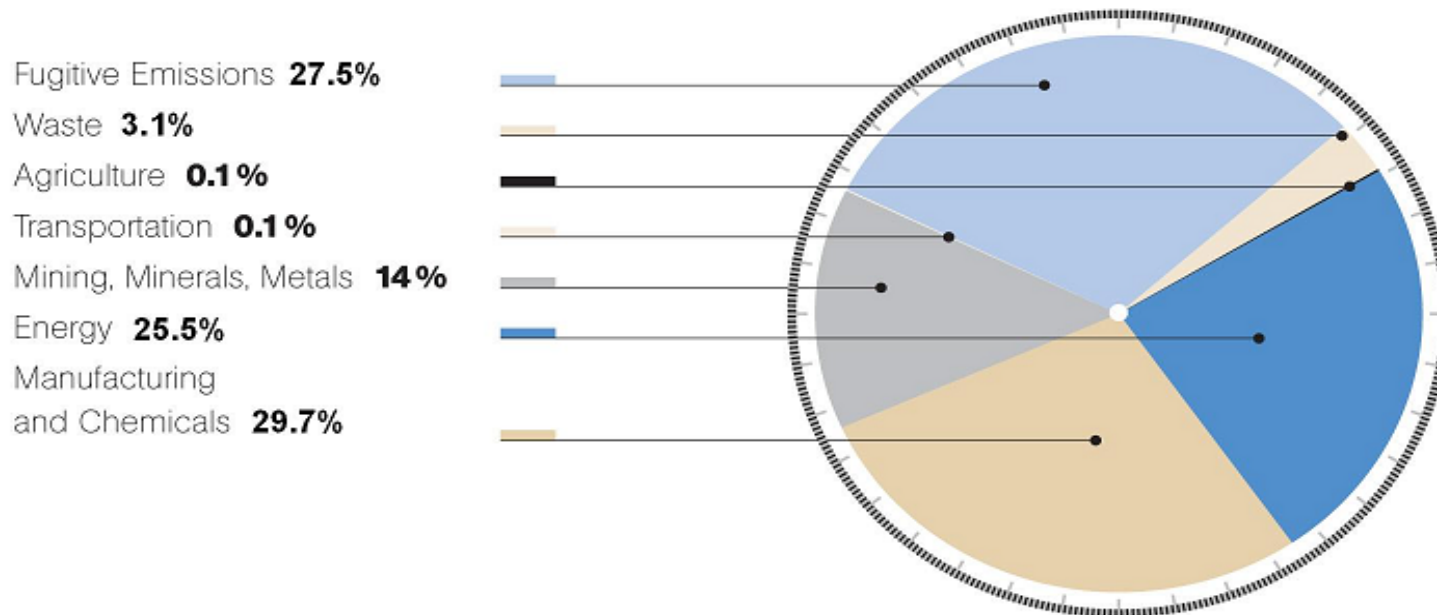
JI Track 2 total emission reductions (proposals), 2008–12, by country



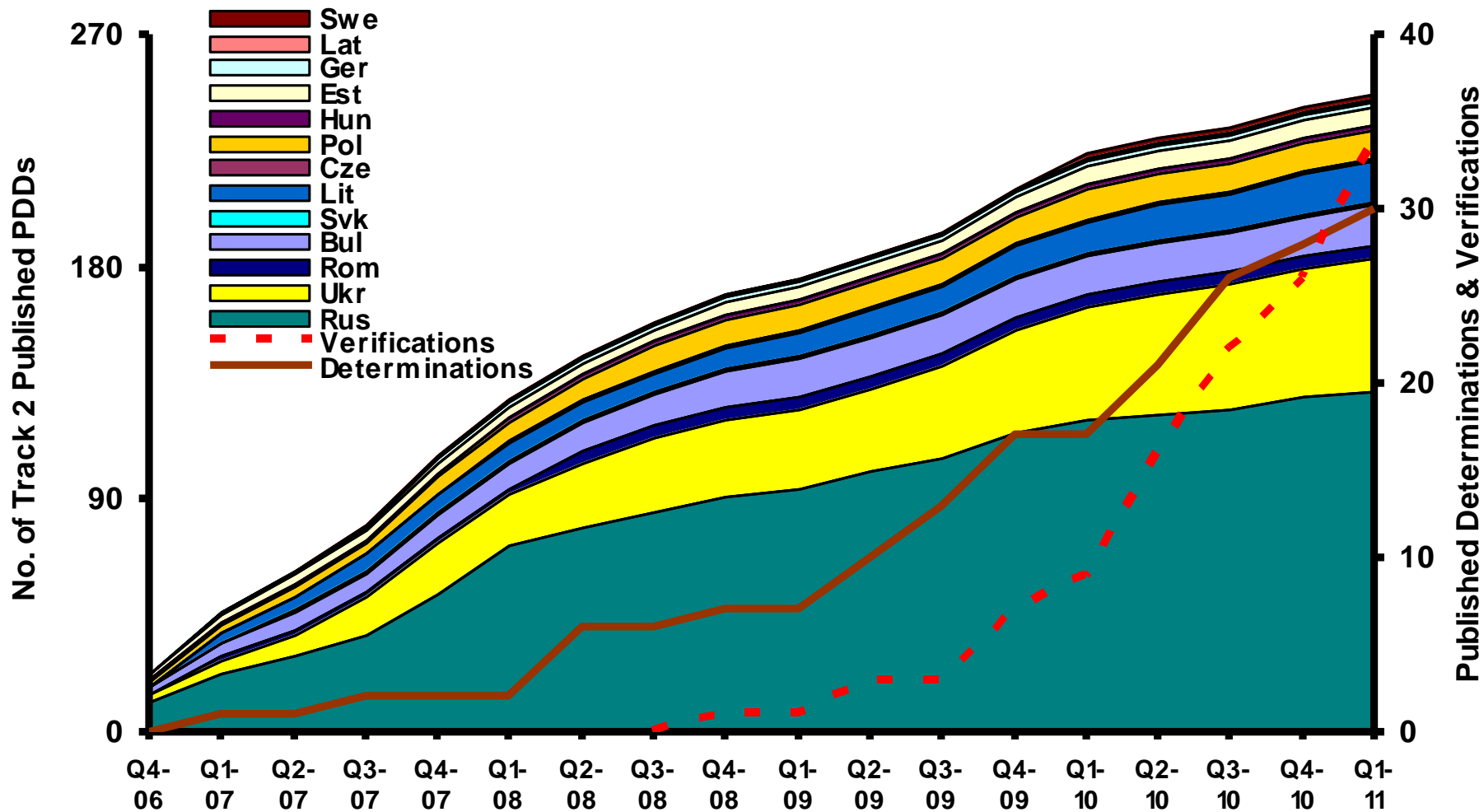
## JI TRACK 2 EMISSION REDUCTIONS BY SCOPE

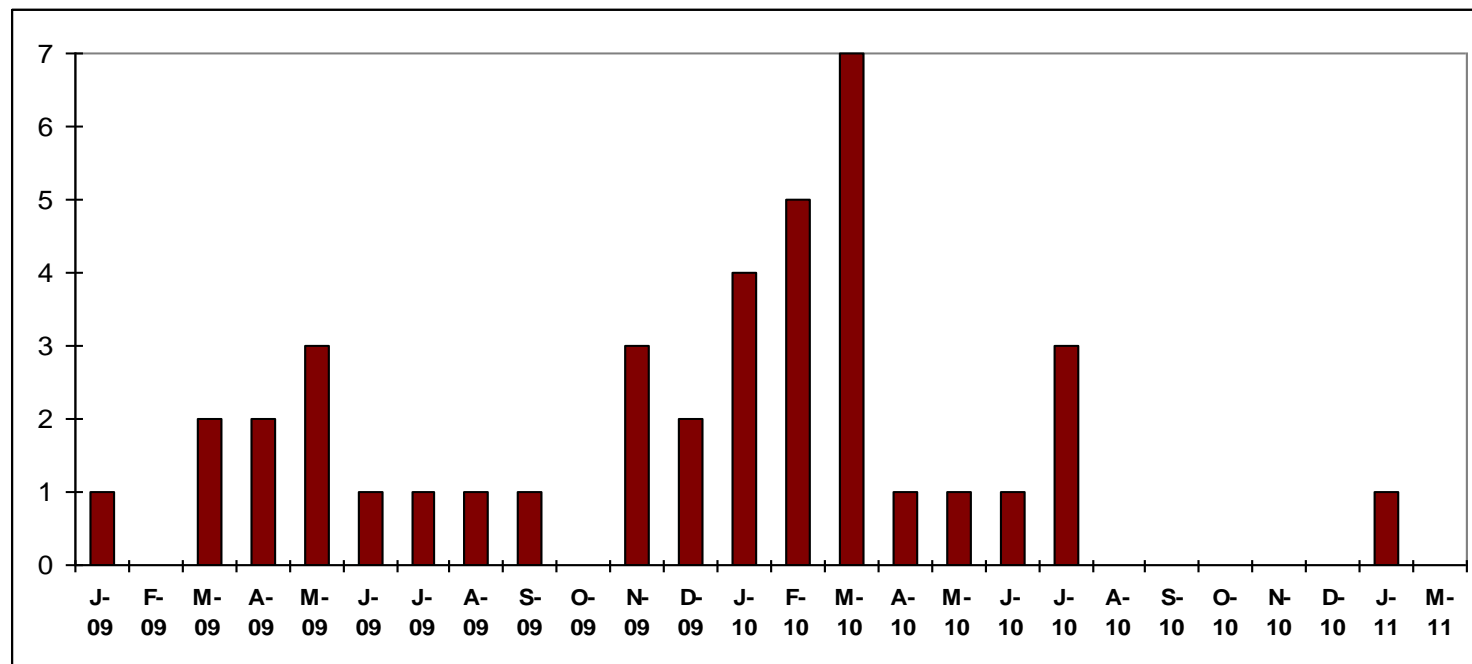

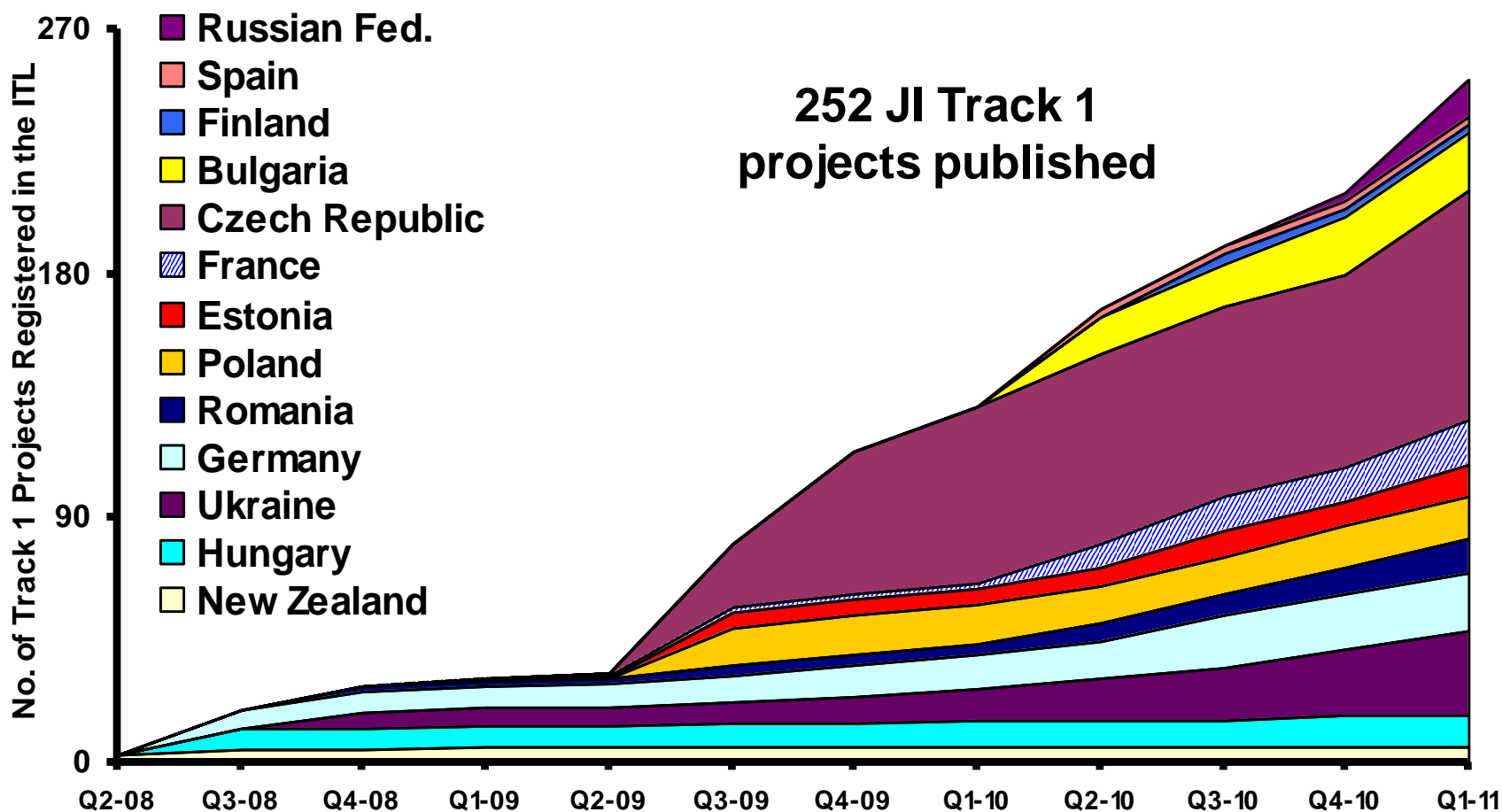

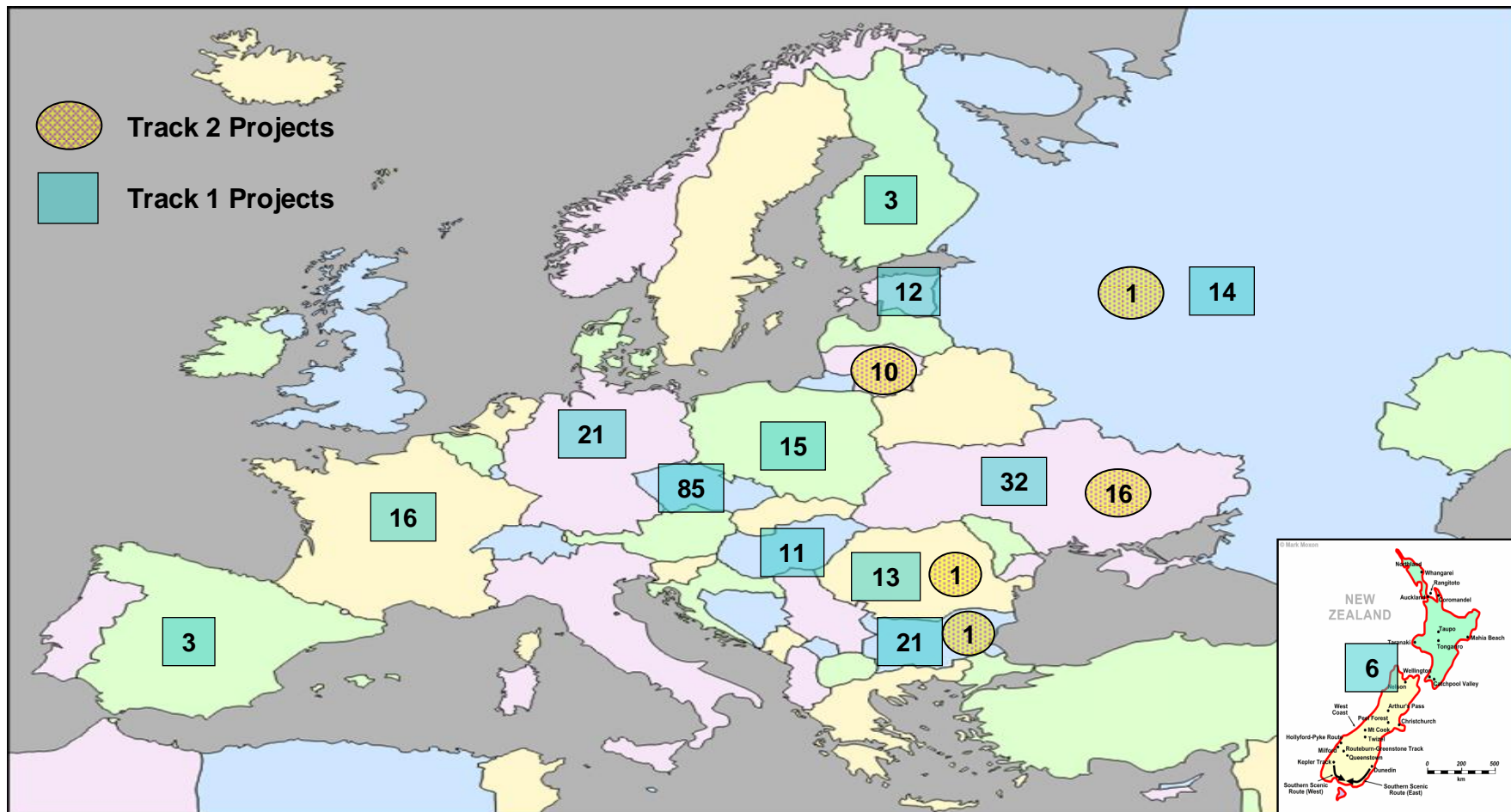

## SUMMARY OF PROJECT STATUS - 20 MAR. 2011

- **246 PDDs & 1 PoA DD** published under Track 2 ~ 380 Mt CO<sub>2</sub> eq.
- **40 PDDs** withdrawn from Track 2 ~ 42 Mt CO<sub>2</sub> eq.
- **30 determinations** regarding Track 2 PDDs (in 5 Parties) published, from which:
  - 29 positive determinations deemed final (43 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>e in 2008-2012)
  - 1 determination rejected by the JISC
  - 0 determination opened for requests for review
- **34 verifications** of emission reductions (generated by determined Track 2 projects) published, from which:
  - 33 positive verifications deemed final (8.3 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>e as ERUs possible to issue)
  - 1 verification opened for requests for review
- **252 Track 1 projects** (in 13 Parties) published on the JI UNFCCC website
