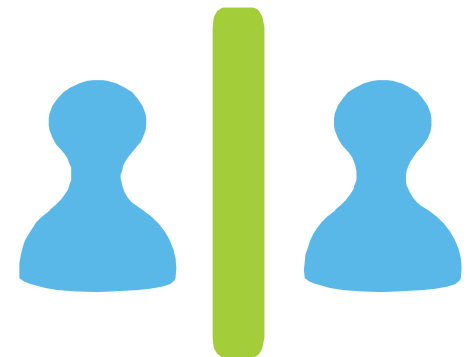

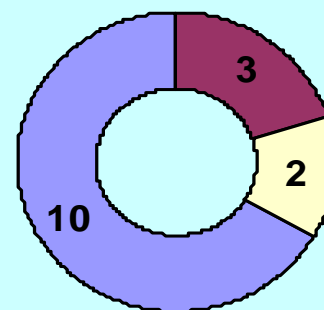


# Present Situation

- **35 experts** in the Roster from Feb. 2007 (after 2 calls)
- 29 determinations/1 detailed review – **60 appraisals by 23 experts**
- **15 experts (only!) with signed contracts in 2011**
- Few non-Annex I and Annex I EITs experts
- More experts with JI knowledge compared with 2007
- Some scopes covered by few experts
- Submissions of determinations growing
- Possibly experts involved in verification

■ Annex I ■ Non-Annex I ■ Annex I - EITs

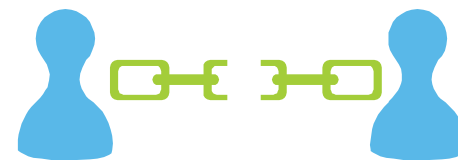


# Background

---

## • JISC at its 3<sup>rd</sup> Mtg. (May 2006)

- Adopted the procedures for reviews
- Adopted the Terms of reference for experts (appraise/review)
- Requested secretariat to launch a **call for experts** (7 July-18 Aug. 2006)



## • JISC at its 4<sup>th</sup> Mtg. (Sep. 2006)

- Adopted the procedures for appraisal
- Established the Roster of experts (**25 experts** selected from 46 applications)\*
- Requested secretariat to launch a new **call for experts** to increase the number and to diversify the expertise (15 Dec. 2006 - 26 Jan. 2007)

## • JISC at its 6<sup>th</sup> Mtg. (Feb. 2007)

- Selected **10 new experts** from 23 applications\*

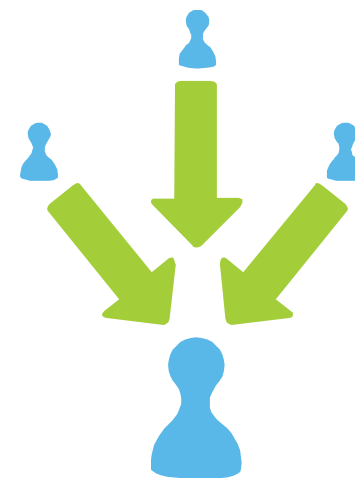
\*Applications pre-evaluated by secretariat and decided by JISC in close sessions

# Activities of Experts from the Roster

---

- **Prepare detailed appraisals of PDD determinations**, indicating if all JI requirements (KP Art. 6, JI guidelines, CMP decisions, JISC decisions) are met and appropriately dealt by AIE
- **Participate in JISC review teams (RTs)** on a case-by-case basis, fulfilling tasks assigned to them:
  - providing inputs
  - preparing requests for clarification to AIE and PPs
  - analyzing information received



# Provisions of the Terms of Reference for Experts

---

## Experts in the roster shall:

- Act in their **personal capacity**
- Be **familiar with the JI guidelines** and CMP decisions
- Have **recognized experience** and knowledge on JI project cycle
- Demonstrate min. 3 years experience on **methodological issues**
- Demonstrate **technical/scientific expertise** (publications)
- Have an **advanced university degree**
- Be able to **communicate fluently** in English and have excellent **drafting skills**
- Be **free from any interest** and act in impartial and non-discriminatory manner



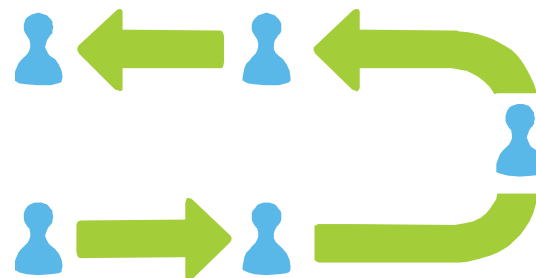
**Experts are compensated with daily fees for good quality and timing**



## Proposed Next Steps

---

- **Launch the call** in the period of 45 days after the JISC 24 meeting
- Secretariat receives and **evaluates the applications** based on ToR
- JISC discusses the **eligible candidates** and selects experts at JISC 25
- **Selected experts** included in roster after signing annual contracts
- Start involving the **new experts** immediately after JISC 25 in appraisals and reviews (possibly in verifications)
