JISC 24

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BACKGROUND

- JISC 23 (Oct 2010)
 - Adopted “JI experience report“ for submission to CMP 6
 - Requested the secretariat to develop JISC workplan up to 2013 taking into account “JI experience report“
- CMP 6 (Nov-Dec 2010)
 - Requested the JISC to implement action area IV of “JI experience report” in particular:
 - (a) Further improving the verification procedure
 - (b) Further streamlining the accreditation process
 - Encourages the JISC to strengthen outreach activities
 - Requested the JISC to make recommendations to CMP 7 on options to build on approach embodied in JI for first review of the JI guidelines



BACKGROUND – cont.

- CMP 6 (Nov-Dec 2010) – cont.
 - Requested the JISC to finalize provisions for charging fees to Track 1 projects
 - Requested the JISC to make recommendations to CMP 7 on amendments to the fee structure

JISC Workplan 2011-2013: Vision

“firmly establish JI as an effective tool of international collaboration for developed country Parties in mitigating their emissions of greenhouse gases and to provide a robust basis for building upon JI as a means of mitigating greenhouse gas emissions in the period beyond 2012”

Objective A: *Greater efficiency in the continued operation of JI*

Actions

1. Processing submissions of project documentation
 2. Processing accreditation cases
 3. Developing contingency plan in JI-MAP to save resources
 4. Revising provisions for the charging of fees
 5. Preparing recommendations to CMP 7 on amendments to the fee structure
 6. Revising relevant policy guidance documents
 7. Exploring possible setting time limit for each phase of the JI project cycle
 8. Making use of electronic decision-making
 9. Considering revisions of guidance to support simple and innovative methodological approaches
 10. Revising JI accreditation procedure
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Objective B: *Enhanced promotion of the mechanism*

Actions

11. Developing a comprehensive communication strategy
12. Exploring to establish DFP Forum
13. Enhancing the secretariat's outreach activities
14. Considering the involvement of other stakeholders further to raise awareness
15. Engaging JISC members more actively in outreach activities

Issue for consideration at JISC 24
