Encouraged the JISC to enhance its communication with designated focal points, independent entities and project participants



Existing Mechanisms

INTERACTION WITH STAKEHOLDERS

The JISC has already established a significant number of mechanisms to interact with the relevant stakeholders and has been generally commended for its responsiveness to the concerns raised in such interactions.

Specifically the JISC:

- Undertakes call for inputs to seek views on policy issues and revisions to requirements
- Interactions with both AIEs and project participants at each meeting, allowing these representatives to provide input regarding issues on the agenda and information regarding the operation of the mechanism
- Organizes tailored workshops to seek views and share experience with JI



Plans for 2011

As contained in the Draft Work Plan and Management Plan

1. Organization of JI roundtable, in conjunction with JISC25:
 - *Suggestion: To focus on the specific matters on the JISC agenda for 2011, call for expressions of interest to be launched by the secretariat*
2. Organization of JI technical workshop, in conjunction with JISC26:
 - *Suggestion: To focus on the longer term issues regarding the operation of JI, secretariat to explore possibilities for collaboration in organization*
3. Continuation of stakeholder interactions at each meeting
4. Secretariat to brief AIEs on the outcome of each JISC (low cost/high impact)
5. Concept note to be developed regarding a DFP Forum
