# Developments in JI market



Romania has been **suspended** to transfer Track 1 ERUs and AAUs as of 27 August 2011. It is likely that Ukraine will face a suspension from mid October 2011 onwards.

As a result **privately-held assets** are frozen by the UNFCCC due reporting issues of a Host Country. JIAG believes that a sanction, as a principle, should **not affect third-parties** and therefore we have called upon the CMP to review this sanction.

Russia has launched a third tender for approvals for an amount of 70 million ERUs and **issued** 22 million ERUs from the first two tenders. However, **transfers** of ERUs from Russia is still limited.

As of 1 August many AIEs are available to JI Project developers.

# Annex 1: Draft guidance on criteria



## Comparable cases approach:

- Current wording is practical and workable.
- On par 12 d (Scale) we have a strong preference for option 1. Option 2 with 5% is very limitative and would make the ‘comparable cases’ not applicable in practise

We reiterate that the CDM concept of prior consideration should **not be introduced in JI** as:

- Additionality is proven by showing that the project would not happen ‘anyway’ through financial or barrier analysis;
- Like in CDM it is **not required** to show that carbon revenues will make the project happen;
- To introduce this concept **at the end of CP1** is rather late.



JIAG **supports** the two draft documents to CMP6 in Durban in its totality



## Annex 4: Fee structure



**JIAG recommends to leave the fee structure unaltered as it seems that the activities of the JISC and the Secretariat are well funded.**



**A different fee structure can be considered for a CP2 with a contribution by **Host Countries** as a good source of income.**

TÜV Rheinland in **April 2011 (!)** already provided the last clarification to the JI-AT Team Leader. JISC failed to take an **electronic decision** on accreditation TÜV Rheinland.

Communication is disrupted:

- The **calls for inputs** not announced through JI news
- Technical workshop not announced at JI News and participants informed about Agenda at **a very late stage.**
- Some final determination/verification only announced through JI News **at a very late stage**
- Input from JIAG initially not made public
