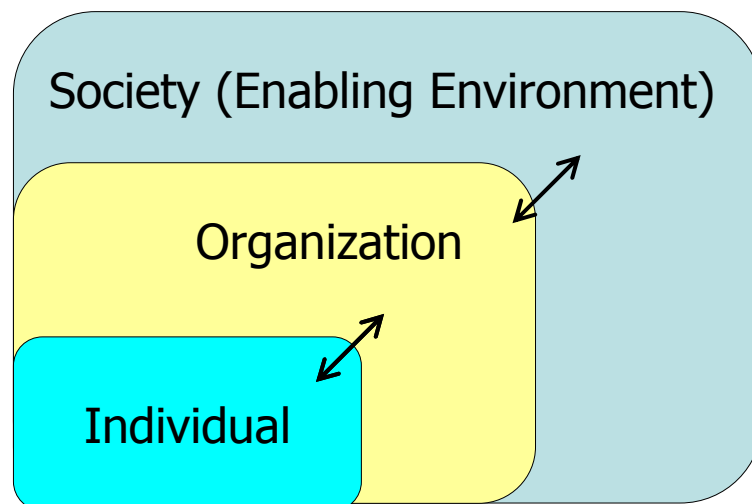
## Capacity & Enabling Environment

- Capacity is “the ability of individuals, organizations and societies to perform functions and solve problems”

JICA (2006), UNDP (2006)

- Enabling environment  
= a capacity at a level of society

- “Rules of the game for interaction between and among organizations” (UNDP 2006)
  - Examples
    - Overall policies
    - Rules and norms
    - Modes of operation
    - Access to Information
    - Public Engagement, etc

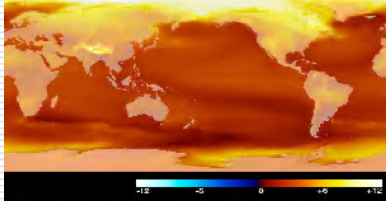
