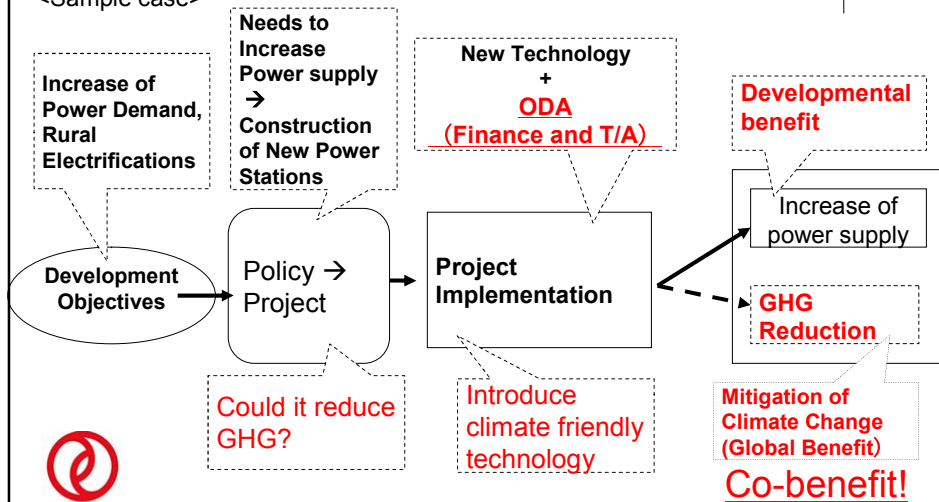

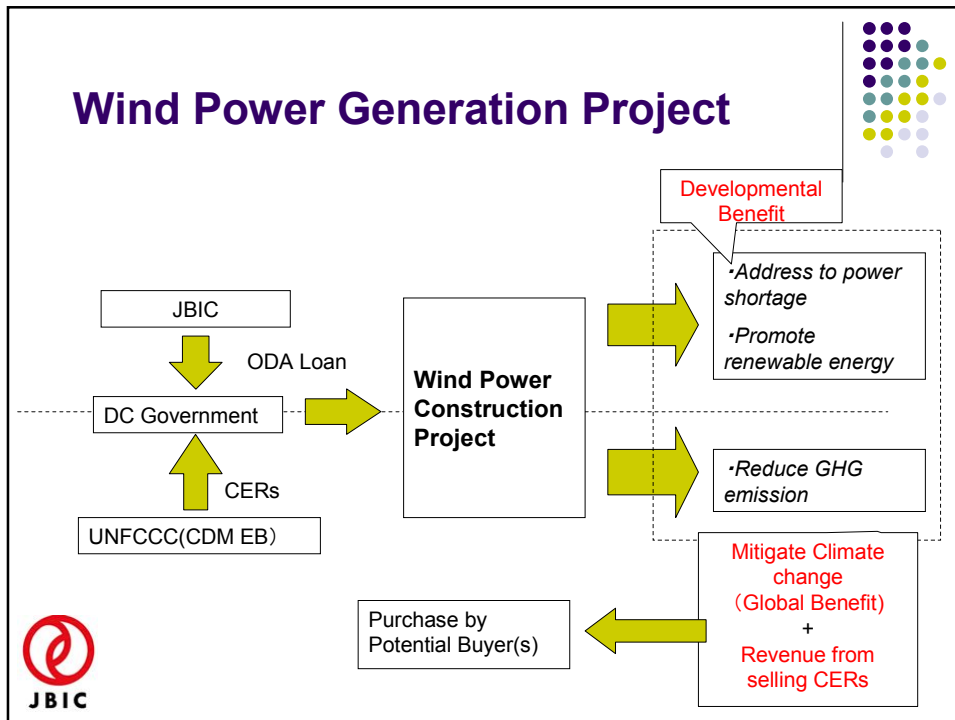


Development effort can generate “Co-benefit”

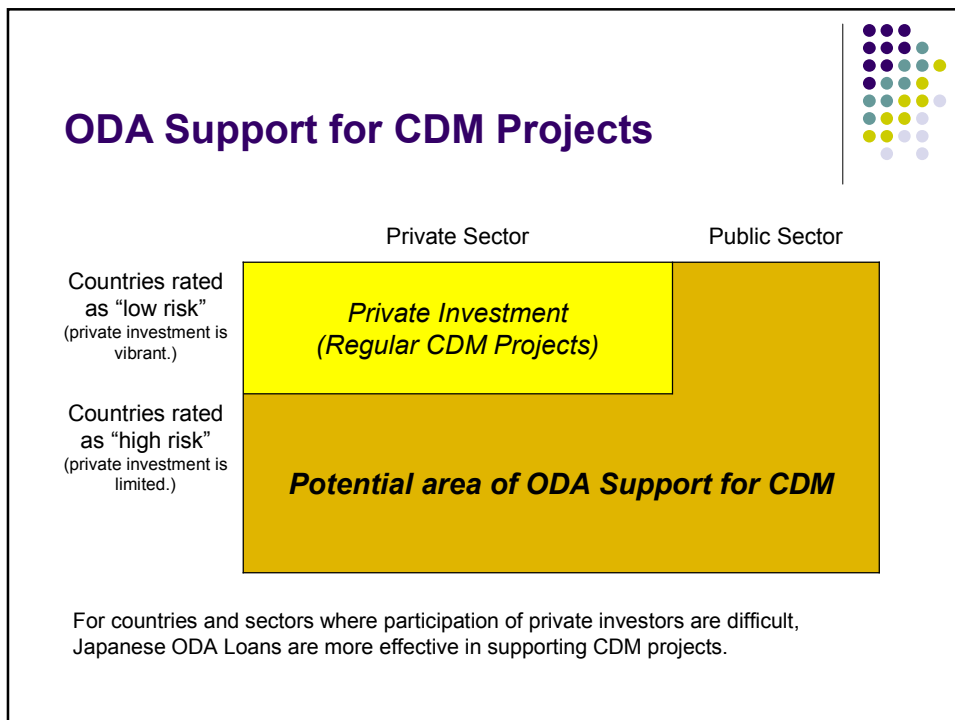

Wind Power Generation Project



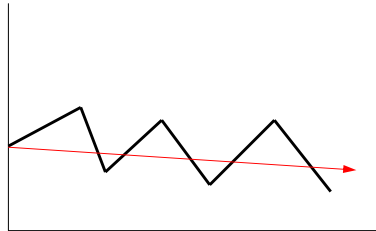
ODA Support for CDM Projects



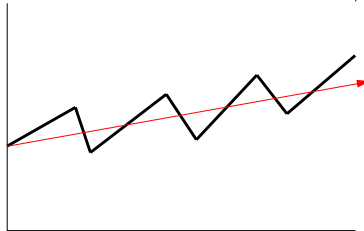
Adaptation to CC through ODA



- Without Adaptation



- With Adaptation



- Adaptation activities could mitigate damage caused by climate change.
 - Without adaptation → Economic growth may be limited since extreme event will wipe out developmental benefit.
 - With adaptation → Adaptation could strengthen resilience of economic growth.
- For donors, “Adaptation” could improve *aid effectiveness*.

Enabling CC activities through ODA



- Mitigation & Adaptation activities could be done by community, private sector, but...
 - Most public works need to be done by the government as national security.
 - Government need to allocate its fiscal budget equitably. → Development strategy, policy, programme.
- Donors and ODA Agencies will consider to provide assistance aligning to DC’s development policy.
