- One of the several CDM promotional initiatives funded by Ministry of Environment, Japan
- Capacity Building project for:
  - Policy-makers  
(officials from the national and local governments)
  - Industries, Business and Financial Agencies  
(private sectors, project developers, consulting firms, banks and other financial institutions, etc.)
  - Civil Society  
(local communities, research organizations, academia, and NGOs)
- Launched in October 2003
- Multi-year Program

- All types of small scale CDM projects



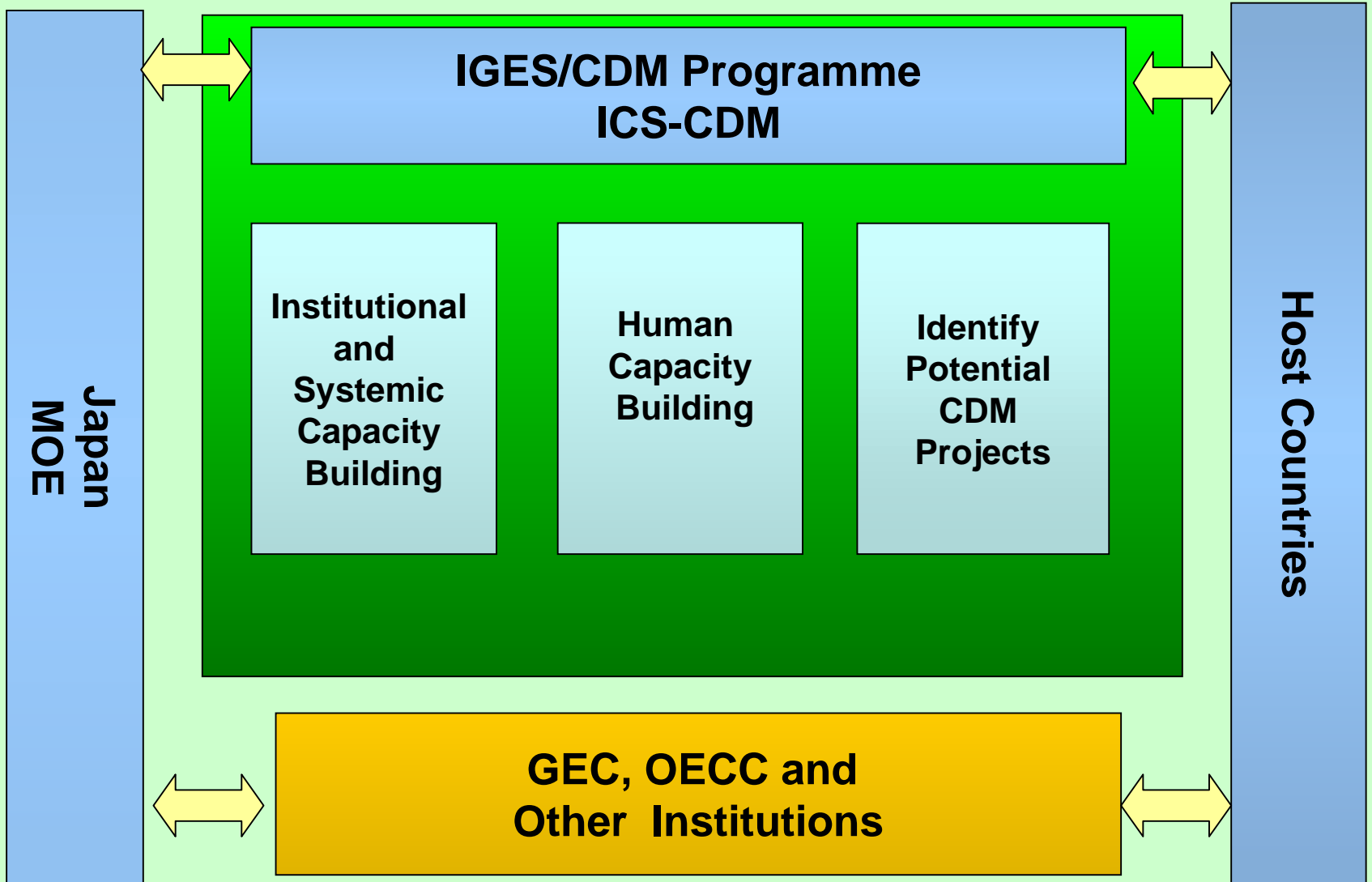

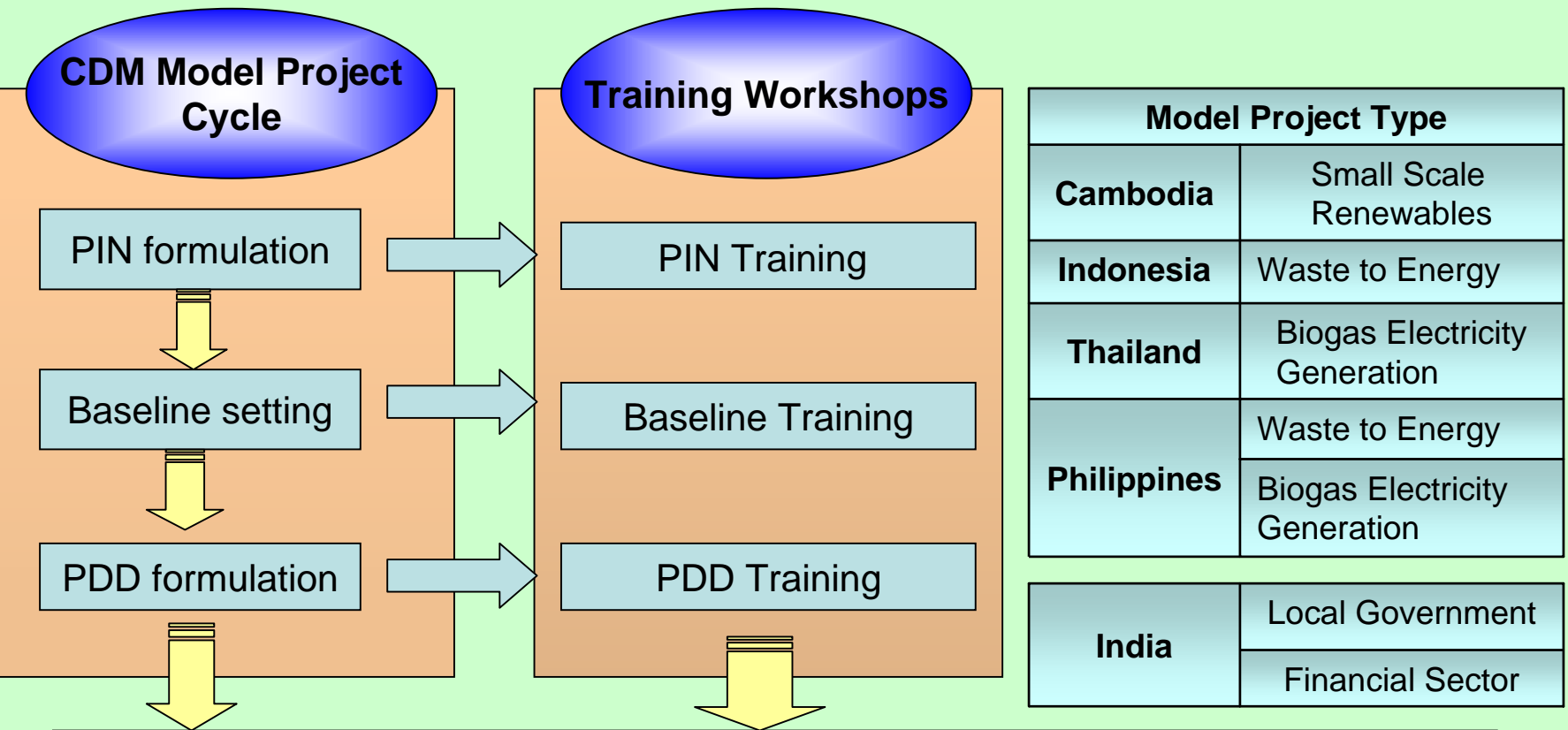
# ICS-CDM/JI Framework

- Collaboration with:
  - Ministry of Environment, Japan (MOE-J)
  - Global Environment Centre Foundation (GEC)
  - Overseas Environmental Cooperation Centre, Japan (OECC)
  - International Organizations
- Publications:
  - CDM and JI in CHARTS
  - CDM Country Guide
- Research on the methods for CDM/JI capacity development through:
  - workshops
  - seminars

- Facilitate CDM projects development
- Accumulate know-how on CDM procedure and modalities
- Develop CDM Country Guide

# Issues and Barriers Identified through ICS-CDM

## Outcome 1: Institutional Arrangement Set-up

- DNA's roles are not clearly understood among relevant ministries and agencies
- Weakness in local institutional arrangements on CDM
- Insufficient information dissemination mechanism
- Information materials unavailable in a local language

# Issues and Barriers Identified through ICS-CDM

## Outcome 2 :

### CDM related procedures formulated

- There is not yet established clear consensus on the national approval procedures
- Insufficient accountability and transparency in project implementation

# Issues and Barriers Identified through ICS-CDM

## Outcome 3: Potential Areas of CDM Projects Identified

- National criteria for sustainable development and its indicators are not developed in some countries
